#### Purpose of the position:

The Livelihood Assistant – Agronomy provides agricultural extension services to farmers, explore and creates essential linkages with agri-business partners to avail services to farmers. Their primary role is to aid individual farmers, groups and cooperatives in Makpandu Refugee Settlement and vulnerable groups from the host community to make better decisions to adopt improved agronomic practices and increase agricultural production. The extension officer shall be constantly armed with the latest techniques and information related to agriculture and relay this information to farmers and agribusinesses

#### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Facilitate Project Implementation: Under the supervision of the Livelihoods Officer, the Project Assistant is required to support implementation of project activities in Makpandu in accordance with the project work plan and objectives, including assist with community outreach and engagement, including beneficiary registration, community-led planning and implementation of project activities; beneficiaries selection takes into consideration gender, age, ethnic identities and clan and tribal affiliations and conduct the beneficiary profile registration and verification;
- Provide agricultural extension services: The job holder deals with daily farming problems have to think fast of practical methods of dealing with these problems, helping them to transition from traditional/subsistence to improved production practices. S/he is responsible for consultation with farmers

and agri-businesses, guides and offer actual demonstration on the latest technologies related to agriculture and on how they can take advantage of such technologies, work with other experts in agriculture to learn more and develop new methods that could advance production.

- Inter-Agency Coordination and networking: Work closely with County Agriculture/Livestock staff
  and other NGOs staff in training, mentorship and coaching of farmers and agri-businesses to facilitate
  promotion of improved agronomic practices
- Community engagement: Motivate farmers to produce marketable or exchangeable surplus beyond
  meeting the family food needs. Conduct activities in a community- and rights-based, participatory manner,
  maintaining an Age, Gender and Diversity (AGD), and conflict-sensitive approach to community
  engagement
- Capacity Building: Assist the Livelihoods Officer in training beneficiaries on diversification of livelihoods strategies, including agronomy, livestock, financial inclusion, cooperative works, vocational training and entrepreneurship among others to enhance their self-reliance

- Diploma in Development Studies, Agriculture or another related field.

- Strong analysis skills (qualitative and qualitative)
