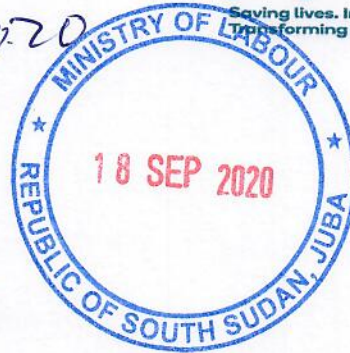

Project Overview

ACHIEVE mechanism, through Jhpiego, is taking over implementation of OVC services in South Sudan aligned with latest PEPFAR Guidance about the OVC package of services and building on 4Children's achievements. As a global mechanism with a local team, ACHIEVE will provide comprehensive case management and primary prevention of HIV and violence among girls and boys ages 9-14. Central to the case management services will be a clinical focus first on identifying HIV positive children, second on identifying children of FSW, and third on identifying the children of HIV positive parents/caregivers. The approach will be household-based case management with the goal of improving access to HIV and other health services and reducing economic vulnerability within households caring for OVC, and specifically ensuring that over 90% of children in HIV clinics have access to OVC services if eligible.

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Key responsibilities

- Lead M&E development of robust M&E systems to track indicators, analyze data, and report results to PEPFAR and USAID
- Ensure the implementation of strong M&E systems on M&E topics including demand-driven trainings, mentoring, and coaching data collection, data quality assurance, data management, analysis, reporting, data demand and use, and other topics as needed
- Design and implement the project's Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning (MEL) Plan
- Ensure project progress against targets is regularly tracked and evaluate project success in achieving objectives and goals.
- Conduct data analysis and data visualization for tracking results, reporting, learning, and adaptive management.
- Ensure data quality through data quality assessments, data cleaning, verification, and validation
- Oversee all data collection efforts, including evaluation, surveys, assessments, and qualitative studies, as needed
- Responsible for maintaining and updating project databases for OVC_Serv and OVC_Stat beneficiaries
- Coordinate with clinical partners in in conducting case conferencing, tracking bidirectional referrals for Children enrolled into the program.
- Lead development of key deliverables such as weekly dashboards, monthly and quarterly reports for USAID.

Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree with 3- 5 years of experience in public health, epidemiology, social work, monitoring & evaluation, demography, biostatistics, statistics, analytics or a related field is required; A Master's degree will be an added advantage



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- Minimum of 3-5 years of work experience in designing, establishing, and managing monitoring and evaluation systems, ensuring data quality, and managing data intensive, performance-based programs;
- Demonstrated experience collecting, tracking, and reporting on PEPFAR MER indicators; experience entering data into PEPFAR's DATIM system
- Experience building capacity of local organizations to conduct M&E activities; experience in M&E for PEPFAR-funded programs strongly preferred
- Experience with data visualization to afford the ease of use of data for decision making
- Demonstrated ability to establish and sustain interpersonal and professional relationships with USAID Mission, implementing partners, and local CSOs
- Strong writing and oral presentation skills, including fluency in English

Preferred Competencies

- Experience with PEPFAR OVC services
- Expertise in development of performance dashboards
- Knowledge of development and maintenance of client level and aggregate databases such as DHIS2
- Ability to develop data collection tools and reporting tools
