

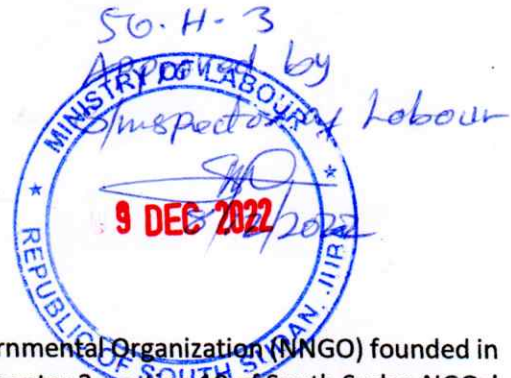

Job Purpose The Community Health Worker will primarily be working out in the community to help facilitate the activities of the **PHCC**. **CHWs** will work closely with medical team, and other stakeholders to improve patient care and outcomes.

- Functional Duties/Responsibilities**
- Follow-up with health management/care plans with both patients and the medical team.
 - Facilitate communication and coordinate services between the community and the health team.
 - Build and maintain positive working relationships with the clients, health manager, nurse clinical officers and all the office staff members.
 - Perform activities with community members to identify community issues and develop, implement, monitor and evaluate strategies and programs to meet community needs.
 - Participate in team work and staff meetings and other meetings and committee work as appropriate to support both service delivery and the organizational goals.
 - Perform and/or organize community health education activities.
 - Provide basic informal counselling and support.
