Nutrition Officer - Roles and responsibilities

- Nutrition officer plays an important role to improve community nutrition practices by
 encouraging peoples, interpersonal-level interventions that create changes in knowledge,
 attitudes, behavior and health outcomes among individuals, families or small, targeted
 groups within a community setting
- As a Nutritionist, he/she takes a leading role in educating people by providing correct information on the nutritional value of foods, food quality and safety, methods of preservation, processing and handling, food preparation and eating to help them make the best choice of foods for an adequate diet.
- A Nutrition officer has direct contact with community members, to conduct community nutrition awareness sessions in public places and social gatherings.
- Nutritionist plays important role to design, coordinate, implement and evaluate population health interventions that are designed to improve matters relating to food and how it impacts on health.
- The nutritionist educates the public on health-related topics including causes and prevention of common illnesses like malaria, diarrhea, eye and skin infections.
- A Nutrition officer supports project /Program staff develop nutrition strategies with focus
 to improve kitchen gardens, school gardening as part of improving nutrition at schools
 and in the community encourage planting vegetables of different variety; food safety and
 food security and the development and reinforcement of food preparation skills across all
 age groups.
- Nutrition Officer provides professional technical assistance and support for Program/project design, planning, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation nutrition activities at community nutrition / health facilities.
- He/she assess patients'/clients nutritional and health needs and provides nutrition advice accordingly.

• Nutrition officer takes lead in providing nutrition awareness and good feeding practices, while counselling mothers of care takers with children attending nutrition and health facilities

 Nutrition officer provides guiding advises on healthy feeding habits to pregnant, lactating/breastfeeding mothers while taking into account their household food security status

- During nutrition sessions to pregnant/ lactation mothers and care takers, he/she provides key hygiene messages on good hygiene practices and disease prevention on specific diseases including malaria, diarrhea and Covid -19
- Nutrition officer works closely with clients to develop healthy eating habits.
- Nutrition officer coordinates and shares nutrition information/data with line departments in health ministries, food security and protection clusters.
- Nutrition officer designs and plans for training and monitoring of community Nutrition Volunteers, activities in nutrition /health facilities.
- Nutrition officer coordinates with MEAL officer to plan and conduct periodic community nutrition assessment, which includes households' food security levels, access to clean water, safe sanitation and hygiene practices that could provide an accurate representation of risk and/or severity of nutrition and other diseases including knowledge on their prevention.
- Supports MEAL officer in nutrition data analysis, and preparation of monthly progress report.

- A minimum of 3- 5 years of field experience and working with related areas with INGO/NGO
- Degree in Nutrition, public health or related field
- Communicates and liaises with stakeholders
- Capacity of team work, ability to work in a Multi-cultural environment
- Intercultural Competence
- Gender sensitive
- Willing to learn and share knowledge
- Professionalism integrity and commitment to project demands
- Innovative, flexibility and independent initiation
- Good time management skill
