General POSITION SUMMARY:

The Incumbent (Plumber technician Consultant) shall support in developing training modules and lessons to train trainees on installation and maintenance of water systems, installation and maintenance of domestic appliances, train the trainees on cutting of pipes to correct length, diagnose plumbing issue and clearly state its remedy.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- The Incumbent shall support in developing training modules and lessons for training trainees on installation and maintenance of water systems, installation and maintenance of domestic appliances.
- The consultant will train trainees on cutting of pipes to desired lengths for use in plumbing systems.
- The plumber consultant will clearly diagnose plumbing issue and clearly state its remedy.



- Train trainees on installing, maintaining and repairing pipes including joins, valves, drains and fixtures in all types of structures.
- Train trainees on common building plans and plumbing needs suitable for such structures.
- Keeping and maintaining records of time spent on a job and materials purchased for the work.
- Preparing budgets and estimating costs to bid on potential work.
- Responding to plumbing emergencies, determining the issue and making a repair
- Performing regular maintenance of plumbing systems to prevent emergencies.
- Performs residential and light commercial service to diagnose and resolve plumbing issues.
- Identifies potential problems to prevent premature and/or unexpected breakdowns/call-backs.
- Train trainees on maintenance and repairing of plumbing systems carrying water, steam, chemicals
 and fuel in heating, cooling and lubricating and other process piping systems
- Training of trainees on common malfunctions of high pressure, air, steam and gas systems.
- Train trainees on repairs and replaces of plumbing fixtures, tests joints and pipe systems.
- Train trainees on interpretation of drawings and specifications to determine layout requirements.
- Train trainees on blueprints, building codes or specifications to determine work details and procedure.
- Support trainees in developing building plumbing plans and inspects structures to assess material
 and equipment needs, establish sequence of pipe installations, and plan installation around
 obstructions.
- Practically support trainees to measure, cut, thread, bend, ream, and install pipe and pipe fittings.

Reporting: Daily reporting of all plumber related activities, issues and problems to FSL and E&E Coordinator.
