Purpose:

We are looking for an experienced Nurse midwife to guide women through their pregnancies and deliver their babies. The midwife's responsibilities include identifying high-risk pregnancies, referring patients to obstetricians as needed, and mentoring student midwives. You should also be able to provide follow-up care to patients after labor.

Major Responsibilities:

- Monitor patient's condition and assess their needs to provide the best possible care and advice
- Observe and interpret patient's symptoms and communicate them to physicians
- Collaborate with physicians and nurses to devise individualized care plans for patients
- Ensure implementation of 6 patient rights medication in all the shift.
- Inspect the facilities and act to maintain excellent hygiene and safety (decontaminating equipment, sanitizing surfaces, preparing beds etc.)
- Provide instant medical care in emergencies



- Assist surgeons during operations
- Supervise and train junior staff and nursing assistants
- Conduct routine health education to the patients and care givers
- Produce timely weekly and monthly reports and proper internal reports for the coordination team.
- With the midwifery skill he/she will be monitoring the health of pregnant women and their unborn babies.
- Educating patients as well as their partners and family members on reproductive health, preparation for parenthood, and antenatal care.
- Teaching patients with pain management techniques to prepare them for labor.
- Conduct safe deliveries at the facility.
