ROLE PURPOSE:

The education project officer will facilitate, coordinate and Supervise all aspects of SIDA Education project implementation in locations) at the county level: He/She will Supervise the distribution of administration, education, and school materials, support teachers' training programmes, follow up, monitor and evaluate project activities to suggest necessary remedies where possible. He/ she will be responsible for ensuring smooth project activity implementation in his/her area of Jurisdiction. He/shel be the the link between SCI and the government at county and Payam level

KEY AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY:

The Project Officer for Education will be expected to:

- Work closely with the project stakeholders such as Local Authorities, implementing partners, and County Education Department to ensure smooth implementation and successful delivery of all project deliverables in his /her area of jurisdiction.
- Compile and submit weekly, monthly, and quarterly work plans and reports to His/her Supervisor
- Conduct regular follow up of SIDA project activities at selected schools, identify teachers/PTAs training needs, plan, organize and report necessary trainings.
- Overseeing teacher training programmes and ensure follow up, monitoring and evaluation is done to support the teachers' development and learning.
- Closely work with in ensuring implementation and reviewing of standard quality benchmarks as well as completing and compiling and submitting IPTT to Field MEAL officer.



- Plan and organize joint school monitoring visits and facilitate feedback sessions and regular discussion forums with CED officials, Payam supervisors, School directors and other relevant stakeholders.
- Work with communities to promote and encourage the enrolment of girls and suggest strategies that will assist in planning, organizing and supporting gender inclusiveness in schools
- Coordinate, support and participate in SIDA project partners' activity implementation to ensure they are in conformity with both SCI and donor regulations and standards.
- Represent Save the Children in meetings. Workshops and activities. Particularly at county and Payam level. As such, he/she should be well informed on Save the Children policies, practices and approaches.
- Develop an effective and sustainable bridge between the local Education Authorities and Save the Children in in County and Payam level by demonstrating good communication. representation, and feedback,
- Establish good relations with che local civil administration and community leaders, particularly the chiefs, sub-chiefs, women's group, parents and children.
- Work closely with the entire education team and other thematic areas in implementing and developing all aspects of the education project with a focus on clarifying to the community the role and responsibilities of the LEAS. Community/PTAs and Save the Children.
- Ensure and facilitae timely requisition and delivery of schools materials supplies and ensure proper distribution plan and documentation is in place,
- Manage and account for cash/floats for activities such as PTA trainings and community mobilization worksthops, local education authorities' capacity building workshops and other components of training programmes.
- Lead workshops for teachers, communities, PTAs, children and others as designated activities related to che value of education and the links between child protection and education.
- Ensure that all SCI supported schools are visited on regular basis, data collected and documented, Develop a monthly individual activity plan and support other stakeholders in developing similar activity plans for effective implementation of SIDA project activities.
