

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TENDER

General Instructions

1.1 ForAfrika invites tenders for construction Materials in Pibor field office, Greater Pibor Administrative Area - Republic of South Sudan.

Tenderers should carefully review the Tender Documents, which comprise of the following:

- (a) Instructions for Tender and Conditions of Tender;
- (b) Tender Declaration;
- (c) Standard terms of a Contract;

Tenderers may seek clarification on the Tender Documents or request further information from ForAfrika at any time prior to the submission deadline, by contacting **ForAfrika – Procurement department** through; **jamss.logs@jamint.com**

Written responses to such requests will be circulated to all tenderers to ensure no individual tenderer is given an unfair advantage.

- 1.2 ForAfrika reserves the right to vary the Tender Documents prior to the submission deadline by notice in writing to all tenderers.
- 1.3 Tenderers must complete the following standard forms:
 - (a) List of requirement; and
 - (b) Tender Declaration.
- 1.4 Tenderers must include all of the above mentioned completed forms, <u>together with a</u> <u>price quotation</u> in a sealed envelope and delivered to the Procurement department at:

- 1.5 The deadline for submitting tenders to ForAfrika is **<u>5:00PM</u>**, **February 17th 2023**. ForAfrika will not accept tenders after this time.
- 1.6 Tenders will be valid for up to 90 days after the submission deadline, and may be accepted by ForAfrika at any time before the expiry of this period.
- 1.7 ForAfrika may decide to award multiple contracts in respect of the Service. In such cases, ForAfrika will invite tenderers who satisfy ForAfrika requirements to provide part of the Service for a lump sum price calculated on the basis of rates submitted by tenderers. If a tenderer agrees in writing to provide the relevant part of the Service for the lump sum price, such agreement shall be deemed to be a firm and binding variation to the original tender submitted by the tenderer.
- 1.8 ForAfrika will notify the successful tenderer(s) in writing if ForAfrika accepts their tender and the successful tenderer(s) will each be required to enter into a contract with ForAfrika.
