Purpose of the position:

To provide overall technical leadership and management support to the nutrition project in **Gogrial East County** and to ensure that the project meets its goals and objectives with significant impact on the target population. Under technical guidance of the Nutrition Program Manager, the position holder will provide strategic direction to the project and ensure achievement of all set indicators is within donor required thresholds.

Key Responsibilities

- Routine management of nutrition project and providing analysis of the situation on the ground in order to determine the immediate needs of the population within Gogrial East and take lead in implementing any changes
- Ensure that the nutrition project is implemented in accordance with Government of South Sudan protocols, budgets, international standards, and program objectives. Coordinate, prepare and manage a work plan to ensure that all planned activities are completed within recommended timeframes.
- Track project budgets and implementation plans to ensure that activities are implemented within planned timeframes and within specified budgets to avoid over or under expenditures

Approved for process
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- Build capacities of project staff to ensure that implementation of OTP, TSFP, inpatient management of malnutrition, community mobilization (including screening and referral of children 6-59 months and PLWs) activities are done in accordance with recommended national and international guidelines.
- Collaborate with other health/nutrition providing partners in Gogri East to ensure harmonized implementation of the program
- Prepare high quality narrative and statistical reports, internal as well as Nutrition Information System (NIS) reports in a timely manner
- Update the CMAM database on a weekly basis and work with M&E team to regularly update project indicator tracking tables
- Ensure selection and management of community nutrition volunteers and mother to mother support groups for promotion of IYCF and other preventive approaches in the community
- Develop and maintain effective working relationships with all stakeholders, including community leaders, NGOs, UN agencies, community-based organizations in project locations to enhance cooperation and coordination;
- Maintain adequate supply chains for Nutrition supplies and medicines. Coordinate with the responsible authorities get SC and OTP supplies from UNICEF, GIK, and or SC to Project locations

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Bachelor's Degree in Nutrition with at least 3 years of hands on experience in managing emergency nutrition programs in conflict settings
- Post graduate training in Project Planning and Management, Public Health or Monitoring & Evaluation will be an added advantage.
- Professional technical experience, including 2 years of implementing nutrition programs in South Sudan is an added advantage.
- Prior training and experience in CMAM and IYCF is a must; proficiency with SMART surveys will be a plus.
- Demonstrated experience in project management, capacity building, project design and budget management
- Strong interpersonal, intercultural and communication skills
- Excellent analytical and written skills, and good computer skills
- Fluency in English required; Arabic is an added advantage
- Additional qualities: ability to multi-task, ability to handle pressure well, ability to improvise, flexibility, adaptability to transition.
