- Provide technical expertise and coordination on climate-resilient agriculture expansion in the implementing areas.
- Collect and validate market findings with local and regional partners on regular basis.
- Establish a network of market actors.
- Business ecosystem mapping, specifically with growth-oriented MSMEs in the agro-food sector and targeted value chains. This involves identifying MSMEs that contribute to a resilient agricultural market.

- Work with cooperatives and financial groups (VSLAs and SACCOs) to provide essential services and enhanced access to finance.
- Technical and organizational support to promote strategies to introduce climate-resilient agricultural practices and inputs across selected value chains.
- provide general support to the project coordinator and management team regarding the preparation of operational activities, budgetary calculations, terms of references for consultants, monitoring and evaluation (M&E) reporting.
- Coordinate with implementing partners under the supervision of the Project Coordinator.
- Assist national and international consultants in carrying out their work.

- Prepare, implement, and document training events, workshops, forums, team meetings and other project activities.
- Represent GIZ in coordination meetings and lead project specific dialogue fora.
- Document lessons learned for subnational and national dialogue.
- Ensure knowledge management, collect, process and distribute relevant information, ensure transparent communication and interaction between government institutions, NGOs and civil society through analyses other media and direct dialogue.
