**Job Title:** Mobile Clinic Team Lead/ Medical Doctor (2 positions)  
**Reporting to:** Emergency Health Manager  
**Location:** Kodok & Manyo  
**Availability:** As soon as possible

### **Purpose of the position:**

The Mobile Clinic team lead oversees a team of Clinical officers, registered nurses, midwives and pharmacists to ensure efficient and effective implementation of integrated medical mobile clinics, community management of acute malnutrition (CMAM) services at a facility and community level/identified mobile clinic sites, in line with national MOH guidelines, programme plans, budget and timelines. The role involves strengthening the capacity of staff at nutrition and medical mobile clinic sites through on-the-job training and ensuring that CMAM, MIYCN and emergency health programmes and other primary health care components are implemented to a high degree of quality. The post holder will also be responsible for representing WVSS and coordination.

### **Major Roles and Responsibilities:**

#### **Supervision of PHC activities:**

Ensuring all health and nutrition activities at facilities and identified mobile clinics sites are implemented in accordance with South Sudanese CMAM, MIYCN and health guidelines.

- Ensuring all nutritional supplies, medical supplies, stationary at all nutrition and health centres are requested and supplied regularly and timely to meet the needs of the beneficiaries.
- Promote active participation of county health departments, community structures such as Boma Health Initiatives

#### **People Management**

Provide daily supervision and mentoring visits to staff members at nutrition sites.

- Manage Clinical officers, midwives, registered nurses and Pharmacists, contributing to their capacity building and career development
- Monitor and review performance of these staff and hold them accountable for meeting their objectives; give corrective feedback where required and take decisive action in the case of poor performance.

#### **Capacity Building:**

Provide needs-based training for WVSS staff and partners on nutrition and health tools that will enable the teams to work effectively.

- Ensure that a sound understanding of CMAM, MIYCN, IMNCI, HMIS, EPI CMR, PMTCT, BEmONC are filters down to front line staff and partners

#### **Others**

Be aware of, understand and comply with all of WVSS's policies and procedures (P4, finance, logistics, HR, security management etc).

- Contribute to ongoing security management and planning as necessary.
- Actively participate in any emergency response if called upon to do so (within the existing programme area or in a new one).
- Undertake other related duties as may reasonably be assigned by the line manager.

#### **Qualifications:** Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Degree in Human medicine and surgery/ Degree in clinical medicine and community health/public health/Degree in Nursing/midwifery from a recognised university
- Diploma in Clinical medicine and community health/public health/nursing or any relevant qualification with minimum of 5 years' experience in running primary health care activities in South Sudan
- Registration with Medical and dental practitioners, Allied health professional, nursing council
- Energetic and self-motivated, with skills in community mobilization, training, and team-building;
- Proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision;
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines
- Be a committed Christian who espouses Christian values throughout his/her work
- South Sudanese Nationals only
