Background information

MI has been actively engaged in today's geographic area of South Sudan since 1996. Our current programming focuses on Central Equatoria and Western Bahr el Ghazal States. The main thematic sectors are Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH), Food & Nutrition Security / Livelihoods (FNSL), Health & Wellbeing, and peacebuilding and strengthening social cohesion. MI aims to implement its projects in accordance with the Humanitarian Development Peace (HDP) Nexus for a sustainable impact of our interventions. To continue our engagement in peacebuilding and contribute to a culture of peaceful coexistence in Yei County, MI seeks to engage a Peace Assistant for school mobilisation to support peaceful conflict resolution between warring individuals.

Through its transitional development assistance project, MI provides assistance to vulnerable populations in Yei



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County, incl. internally displaced persons (IDPs), refugees, returnees, and host communities. The project covers multiple sectors, incl. food security, nutrition, livelihood support, Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH), mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS), and peacebuilding. As part of the peacebuilding component of the project, MI implements community sensitization activities to foster dialogue on the importance of peaceful coexistence and non-violent conflict resolution. One such activity involves the planning and broadcasting of interactive radio programmes on a peace-related topic where listeners have the opportunity to call in and contribute to the show, sharing their insights and concerns. In order to continue this these activities under the project's peace component, MI is looking for a Peace Assistant who will ensure the continued existence and functioning of peace clubs and the integration of peace education in the curriculum.

Core responsibilities

- Plan interactive radio programmes, incl. background research, community engagement, script writing, invitation of guests, liaison with radio station, etc.
- Conduct radio programmes/shows on a bi-weekly basis, acting as an impartial, politically neutral moderator
- Regularly engage with target communities, collecting their suggestions for topics to be covered
- Regularly (at least monthly) provide a report detailing the progress of activities
- Consult with the peacebuilding and project management teams to identify synergies between different peace activities and other project components
- Where feasible, support other peace staff in the implementation of peacebuilding activities, incl. organizing social events on peace topics
- Other tasks as required

Qualifications

The ideal candidate should possess the following profile:

- At least two years of relevant experience in communication or journalism, ideally with radio stations
- Excellent communication and public speaking skills and ability to interact with listeners
- Cultural sensitivity and demonstrated ability to work with people of diverse backgrounds
- Proficient use of common computer software (esp. MS Word, Outlook, Teams, Excel)
- Previous experience in peacebuilding or in the humanitarian sector is considered an asset
- Fluency in English and one of the following languages is required: (Juba) Arabic, Bari (or dialects thereof), Kaliko. Other languages are considered an additional asset.
