Fleet Coordination

- Propose and organize specific planning for upgrading of fleet technical capacity in terms of equipment.
- Help identify and assess local shops where vehicles can be serviced.
- Submit mileage and fuel consumption data for vehicles to the fleet officer each month.
- Drive vehicles for Medair business purposes.
- Manage fuel and ensure vehicles are refueled weekly
- Work in hand with fleet officer to ensure spare parts are well managed

Driver management

- Schedule which vehicles specific drivers are to use each day.
- Coordinate daily vehicle needs for all departments by scheduling drivers' movements to/from sites in and around Juba.
- Capacity build Conduct regular, practical, on-the-job training of driver on proper driving techniques; basic preventative maintenance; basic service procedures.
- Manage and coach Juba base drivers in a way that fits Medair values.

Driving

- Drive Medair staff, visitors, and project materials to and from various locations in and around Juba to support Medair programming.
- Coordinate and oversee Juba drivers.
- Liaise with all drivers to track vehicle service and repair needs.
