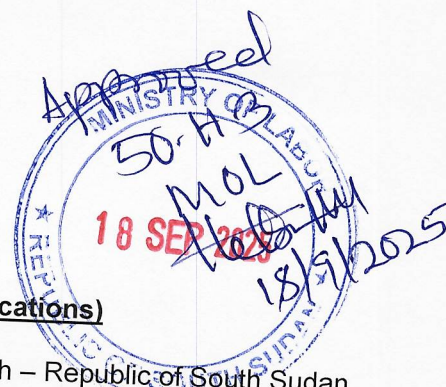

Rapid Response Officers (Multiple Field Locations)



The Carter Center (TCC) Provides Technical Support to the Ministry of Health – Republic of South Sudan for the Guinea Worm Eradication Program (SSGWEP), Trachoma Control Program (TCP) and River Blindness and Lymphatic Filariasis (RB/LF) Programs. The Carter Center is currently seeking to recruit dynamic, qualified candidates for the Position of **Rapid Response Officers** to be based in the rural field locations within South Sudan where The Carter Center operates.

Position Title: Rapid Response Officers (Multiple field locations)
Duty Station: Multiple Field Locations.
Duration: Current- August 31st, 2026
Closing Date: 07th October 2025

Job Purpose: The **Rapid Response Officers** under the overall supervision of the **Senior Technical Advisor** will support field activities of Community-Based Programs supported by The Carter Center.

Key Responsibilities:

- Ensure adherence to all TCC, SSGWEP guidelines and regulations.
- Support field teams to effectively strengthen health education and awareness about GWD transmission, prevention and cash reward for reporting of cases and animal infections.
- Provide technical support to Senior Program Officers (SPOs), Program Officers (POs), Field Officers
- Plan, coordinate and implement response at the field level II and III areas this is through the MOH state
- Serve as a point-of-contact, as needed, for CHD/surveillance teams responding to provisional cases
- Manage the GW hotline, in collaboration with the Data Team.
- Assist in conducting trainings on responding to GW, as needed. This should be focused on response
- Support writing the case/infection investigation report as needed.
- Identify gaps in the implementation of surveillance and intervention activities in priority areas
- Assist in conducting periodic Data Quality Assurance (DQA) GW case searches and KAP surveys.
- Assess the capacity of IDSR to detect, report, investigate, and respond to all rumours, suspects.
- Ensure GW data is reported through the DHIS2 system..
- Stay up-to-date with SSGWEP Secretariat memos, SOPs, guidelines and directives.
- Work closely with MOH at State, County and Boma as well as CHD's levels

Person Specifications:

- **South Sudanese National(s) only**
- Fluency in English and Arabic
- Minimum qualification; Degree, Diploma in Public Health, Nurse or related knowledge of Guinea Worm
- Three (3) years of previous work experience with a reputable Health Institution, NGO preferred
- Willingness to live and work in remote locations under basic conditions.
