



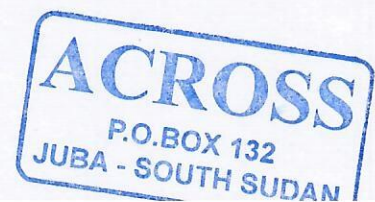

INTRODUCTION:

ACROSS is an Interdenominational Church base organization which strives to provide humanitarian assistance (including emergency/relief, rehabilitation and development work) to local communities, internally displaced persons, refugees and other vulnerable communities to enable them to realize their purpose and value as human beings. ACROSS in South Sudan is urgently looking for a competent qualified South Sudanese national for the position of Water, Sanitation & Hygiene Officer (WASH).

• Key areas of responsibility:

- Mobilize communities in collaboration with community leaders, to engage 200 households and families to participate in Community Led Total Sanitation (CLTS), to construct pit latrines at the households' level in ACROSS supported villages.
- Teach mobilized households to discourage open defecation and adapt use of latrine as a proper method of human waste disposal to promote good sanitation and hygiene practices as a mean for disease prevention.
- Work closely with mobilized households show and teach them how to construct pit latrine at the household, Tippy Tape, dish rack, bathing shelter, mud stove and rubbish pit, using local materials.
- Work closely with WASH partners and state directorate for water, sanitation, and hygiene to share plans and present ACROSS WASH activities in the WASH monthly cluster meeting are properly coordinated.
- Ensure CLTS activities are well implemented, monitored, and supported in the household selected.



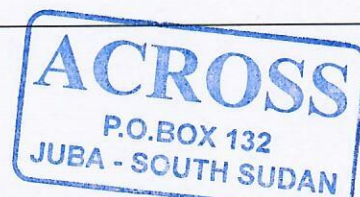
- Ensure weekly and monthly activities plans are timely implemented as per project plans.
- Compile timely activity and monthly reports that feed into midyear and annual partner's consolidated narrative reports.
- Ensure that open defecation is eradicated in the CLTS target villages during project lifecycle.

Require education skills and experience:

- **Bachelor's degree/Diploma in public health or community development or environmental studies or equivalent.**
- Higher education and professional courses or on WASH and CLTS would be an added advantage.
- At less five years' experience with NGOs/UN agencies implementing WASH activities including CLTS intervention in rural communities in South Sudan.
- Excellent in supervision and project management, planning, implementation, analytical and presentation skills.
- Proven experience in working with community in rural areas in South Sudan
- Computer proficiency in MS office (word, excel, and PowerPoint) and other common analysis software.
