**Purpose of the Job:**

The overall objective of the proposed consultancy is to produce audio-visual material to be used for epilepsy / Nodding Syndrome awareness creation and training purposes.

**Project Specific Objectives:**

The specific objective is to organize and perform a participatory theatre session in Maridi, with People with Epilepsy / Nodding Syndrome (PWE/NS) and their families, and to film it.

**General Tasks of the Consultant:**

Under the direct supervision of the NSA Consortium Coordinator, the consultant is expected to:

1. Organize and perform a participatory theatre session addressing local attitudes, practices and lack of knowledge concerning epilepsy and Nodding Syndrome in Maridi (South Sudan).
2. Produce audio-visual material by filming the above-described participatory theatre session.

**Expected Deliverables**

The Consultant is expected to produce and share the following deliverables:

- (i) Brief inception report (max 3 pages).
- (ii) Final Participatory Theatre script, in English.
- (iii) Raw audio-visual material recorded.
- (iv) Edited video.
- (v) Final report, with highlights of the interactions between the actors and the audience held during the Participatory Theatre session.



### Job Requirements

The Consultant can be either an individual, a team or an organization. In all cases, the Consultant(s) shall be able to demonstrate:

- Professional and significant experience in the performance of Theatre activities – “Participatory Theatre” or “Forum Theatre” would represent an additional advantage.
- Documented human rights-related activism is a plus.
- Excellent verbal and writing skills in English and in local languages.
- Strong interpersonal skills and capacity to work with people at all levels and with different cultural backgrounds.
- At least 2 years of experience in producing audio-visual material for media outlets and/or development organizations.
- Excellent technical capacities (e.g., state of the art filming equipment, preferably in High Definition) to ensure smooth and high-quality production.
- Necessary permits / licenses to carry out video-recordings.
- Committed to work and meet the deadlines as agreed with the NSA Consortium Coordinator.
