PURPOSE OF THE POSITION:

JOB SUMMARY: HFO is looking for two qualified Midwives with competence and officient midwifery skills (BEmONC& CEmONC) to deliver and support Pregnant, Newborns, Lactating



mothers and in-patients of all ages in a mobile health site. Such services shall treat all people with dignity, respect, care and compassion, recognizing their individual health beliefs, needs and values.

THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ENROLLED MIDWIFE;

- Examining and monitoring pregnant women
- Assessing care requirements and writing care plans for Antenatal visits and OPD.
- Conducting safe and clean deliveries in the mobile clinic and do APGAR scores for all babies and report any abnormality to Clinical Officer.
- Undertaking antenatal care in PHCU and providing family planning to the needy women.
- Give misoprostol or Ocitocine injection for the prevention of PPH und authorization of Clinical Officer.
- Carrying out screening tests in ANC such as VCT, Malaria RDT and Syphilis test.
- Providing information, emotional support and reassurance to women and their partners
- Taking patient samples, pulses, temperatures and blood pressures
- Caring for and assisting women in labour
- Monitoring and administering medication, injections and intravenous infusions during labour
- Monitoring the foetus during labour
- Advising about and supporting parents in the daily care of their newborn babies
- Supporting patients to cope with miscarriage, termination, stillbirth and neonatal death
- Keeping good records for ANC and writing the reports and submit it to the Clinical Officer or Health Officer In-charge of the PHCU.
- Teaching TBA and training junior or Community midwives on daily bases.
- Identifying high-risk in pregnancy and referring them as soon as possible whenever there
 is any malpresentation, obstructed labour, severe Amaemia and Pre-eclampsia or
 eclampsia to the state hospital/
- Midwives may work on a rota and be on call to provide care on a 24-hour basis.

REQUIREMENTS;

- Certificate in Midwifery at the recognize College/Institutions.
- At least two to three years of experience in conducting deliveries caring for New born babies and mothers among others in the hospital.
- Fluent English in writing and speaking, Arabic then local language is an advantage.
- Should have computer skill in MS word and excel.
- Knowledge of MVA &DnC or CEmONC & BEmONC.



- Midwife must have registration certificate from South Sudan Medical Council or Sudan
- Midwife must have knowledge in EPI activities or routine vaccinations.
