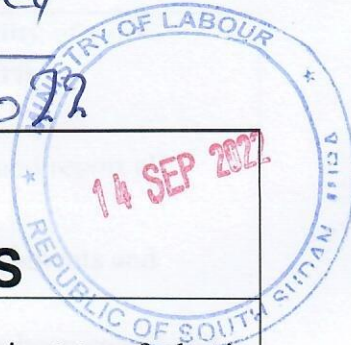

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENTS

PROGRAM/DEPARTMENT SUMMARY:

Mercy Corps began programming in Sudan in 1985, and has been operating in states of what is now South Sudan since 2005; operations have continued since the independence of South Sudan in 2011. We have been working to meet people's immediate needs, and with communities, to build local capacity and promote economic development, especially with the eruption of violence in December 2013. Mercy Corps South Sudan's priority areas are food security and livelihoods (focusing on cash assistance, market-based solutions in agriculture and economic development), WASH and Education. Mercy Corps has been implementing project which combine agricultural, economic development, WASH, Education and other humanitarian interventions to tackle the convulsive crises affecting vulnerable communities. Mercy Corps has worked to build relationships with local government and other actors, which has enhanced our understanding of local contexts and the multiple stakeholders involved.

GENERAL POSITION SUMMARY:

The Senior WASH officer will be responsible for providing high-quality, evidence-based water, sanitation and hygiene promotion services in the areas in which Mercy Corps works. The incumbent plays a critical role in providing life-saving information and services to people affected by conflict.

Mercy Corps seeks senior WASH professional with experience in any of the core areas related to WASH.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- **Oversee and ensure high quality work at all Mercy Corps construction sites.**
 - Coordinate with Mercy Corps Officer contractors to ensure site handovers and management visits.
 - Oversee the construction of WASH facilities by Mercy Corps contractors and ensure adherence to technical specifications in line with Mercy Corps policies and procedures.
 - Produce daily site visit reports for all construction works.

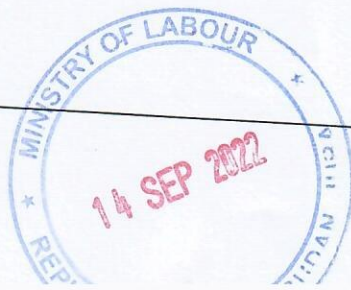


- Propose ways to improve construction team efficiency and quality of work.
- **Document all activities in the field and produce construction reports**
 - Keep detailed field log of all activities done in field
 - Fill out daily field visit report when visiting construction sites and report all problems to supervisor(s)
 - Produce weekly report for team leader on the week's accomplishments and challenges
 - Produce final construction report once construction at a site has been completed (including as-built drawings and updated specifications).
- **Supervise Infrastructure construction**
 - Supervise construction of WASH infrastructure (Latrines, Borehole drilling, solarization)
 - Assist in any other construction activities that may be part of the Mercy Corps programs
- **Produce/Update construction documents as needed**
 - Produce BOQs, technical specifications, and drawings for all Infrastructure any other projects Mercy Corps may get involved in.
 - Review construction documents before work begins and keep a log of modifications
- **Represent Mercy Corps externally**
 - Represent Mercy Corps to WASH cluster, State, communities, and local leaders meet.

KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE:

Requirements:

- Degree/Diploma in Building and Civil Engineering Preferred from a recognized institution of learning
- Knowledge and experience of at least 2 years in managing and supervising construction works
- Excellent communication skills (both written and oral) English required, Excellent communication skills (written and oral); English and Local dialect(Arabic,) is required
- Good computer skills including Excel, Word, AutoCAD
- Experience with supervision of construction (structures) – Ability to produce Bills of Quantities (BOQs) and technical specifications
- Ability to produce construction drawings using AutoCAD
- The ideal candidate must be a resident or willing to reside in the project areas
- Ability to ride a motor bike with valid riding permits is desirable



SUCCESS FACTORS:

High-quality deliver of WASH services to people affected by conflict and returnees returning to their homes. Mercy Corps Team members represent the agency both during and outside of work hours when deployed in a field posting or on a visit/TDY to a field posting. Team members are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner and respect local laws, customs and MC's policies, procedures, and values at all times and in all in-country venues.
