Purpose of the position:

A Program Officer for Resource Acquisition to facilitate program design and resource acquisition for both emergency response and resilience and recovery programming with high standards of appropriateness, timeliness, and effectiveness. The purpose of the position is to work with the Business Development Manager and lead multi-departmental teams in developing and coordinating proposals and concept papers for multi-sectoral relief and recovery programs as well as leading grants acquisition processes for assigned zone.

The Program Officer will also liaise with potential and current donors and other external partners to establish relationships that promote fund acquisition and program collaboration.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Resource Acquisition

- Assess new opportunities for potential risks and facilitate robust go/no-go decision guidelines and signed risk assessment protocols
- Convene and lead multi-departmental teams to design and develop new proposals and concept papers to bilateral and multilateral donors for assigned geographical zone
- Ensure quality and timely submission of concepts, proposals, reports, and amendments
- Support Business Development Manager and Resource Acquisition and Partnerships Director in building a robust proposal pipeline for assigned geographical zone
- Represent needs of the assigned zone and propose unsolicited ideas and concepts when relevant

Partnerships and relationships management

- Lead the process of selecting partners for new proposal developments
- Support the due diligence and partners capacity assessment processes
- Coordinate with selected partners for all inputs for new proposal developments
- Facilitate signing of Partnership Agreements when new projects are secured
- Include partners and partner orientation in start-up workshops
- Serve as point of contact for UN Agency donors at the zonal level

Grants quality and compliance

• Liaise with Programs teams to ensure donor reports are complete and compliant and submitted on-time



- Lead process of grant amendments or revisions during the implementation period
- Maintain resource acquisition processes and protocols for tracking reporting

Knowledge management

- Track all opportunities on a monthly basis using Horizon and resource acquisition department tools
- Ensure safe and organized document storage for each new award
- Suggest and participate in after-action reviews for proposal development processes
- Work with relevant teams in building an evidence base for project models and approaches vital to communicating project impact
