# I Background of the Afia WASH Project

Afia Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (Afia WASH) Project is a USAID funded 5-year project from October 2021 to September 2026 with an overall objective of expanding gender-transformative sustainable access to basic safe drinking water, basic sanitation coverage, and increase uptake of key hygiene behaviors to improve health and household resilience in accordance with USAID/South Sudan's Strategic Framework. Afia WASH is being implemented in the following 6 counties Jur River, Wau (Western Bahr El Ghazal state), Kapoeta North, Budi (Eastern Equatoria state) and Akobo and Uror in Jonglei State

The overall goal is strengthened by the following three key objectives which also form the project components:

- 1. Sub-national and private WASH sector coordination and management strengthened.
- 2. Inclusive, resilient, WASH service delivery expanded and strengthened (construction of new or rehabilitation of existing WASH infrastructure).
- 3. Key WASH behaviors adopted by target communities and addressing harmful gender norms.

## 2 Scope of the Assignment

The main scope of this assignment is the implementation of CLTS as a behavior change tool to increase the construction and use of latrines towards achieving open defecation free status in 10 villages in Akobo County.

The CLTS facilitators will be embedded in Akobo office during the course of performance.

## 3 Objectives of the Assignment

The main objective of this assignment is to achieve ODF in at least 2 villages in Akobo County by the end of March 2024.

## 4 Specific Tasks

N/ DT Global

- Trigger CLTS in ten villages (10) identified and selected. A list of names of the 10 villages will be
  provided to the CLTS facilitators. Form sanitation committee in each triggered village and work
  with them to identify any gaps and challenges and provide opportunities to strengthen the
  committees in their work.
- Conduct follow up of CLTS latrines with the sanitation committees and collect data on daily basis
  in the 10 trigger of villages and present it to the sanitation specialist.



Conducts daily hygiene promotion in the triggered villages (Handwashing) using IEC materials developed by Afia WASH Project to achieve 100% Households with and using handwashing facilities (tippy tap) including use of soap/ash and report progress to sanitation specialist.

#### 5 Deliverables

- Formation of 10 sanitation committees
- Draft CLTS triggering report.
- Draft daily follow up reports.

#### Level of effort

The level of effort is estimated for a period of three (3) months.

The assignment period will be from November 1, 2023, to January 31, 2024.
