Project Background:

The MELS activity serves as the Mission’s primary mechanism for monitoring, evaluation, and learning and adaptive management services for ongoing activities and programs. In a dynamic operating environment, MELS provides USAID/South Sudan with flexible, demand-driven technical, analytic, and advisory support in order to strengthen collaboration, learning and adapting (CLA); promote institutional memory; produce monitoring, evaluation, learning products as appropriate; strengthen knowledge management and organizational learning (KMOL), organizational effectiveness and operational efficiency; and strengthen data-driven decision-making through an efficient use of GIS and other innovative spatial analysis.

Position Summary:

The Protection Systems Strengthening Coordinator (PSSC) serves as the MELS lead in implementing the USAID/South Sudan’s Office of Humanitarian Assistance (OHA) initiative to strengthen the system of protection services across South Sudan. The initiative is being implemented within the framework of collaborating, learning, and adapting (CLA) and is dependent upon active stakeholder participation, engagement, and ownership. The PSSC will be the principal point of contact with OHA, the OHA implementing partners (IPs), and/or other stakeholders in the protection space. Working with OHA and the stakeholder Steering Committee, the PSSC will serve as the nexus for the coordination, planning, conduct, tracking and reporting of the various activities that will comprise this initiative. The position reports directly to the MELS Deputy Chief of Party (DCOP). This is a Short-Term Technical Assistance (STTA) position based in Juba, South Sudan.



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Responsibilities.

- Lead the preparation of a protection workplan in line with the Mission's protection vision,
- Organize stakeholder events ensuring the necessary resources and logistical requirements are available,
- Lead the preparation of information and communication products that facilitate successful establishment of a robust protection system,
- Serve as note-taker, rapporteur or facilitator for meetings or workshops,
- Perform any other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree in any relevant field of study.
- A minimum of five years' work in the humanitarian sector in South Sudan; protection experience highly desirable.
- Exceptional demonstrable English language writing, presentation, and conversational skills.
- Proven expertise in activity planning, organizing, and tracking.
- Fluency in MS Office suite required, working knowledge of data analysis applications such as SPSS and STATA a plus.
- A self-starter, comfortable in taking the initiative, working individually and in teams.
