OBSTETRICIAN-GYNAECOLOGIST (1)-RENK

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, non-governmental, medical relief organization which provides assistance to populations in distress, to victims of natural disasters and armed conflict irrespective of race, gender, religion, creed or political convictions.

MAIN PURPOSE

Implement gynecological and obstetrician procedures, performing any other prior treatment required, during or immediately after a woman has given birth in order to improve women's reproductive health and to reduce pregnancy, delivery and neonatology risks. This will be done in accordance with **MSF** policies, protocols and universal hygiene standards and in multidisciplinary collaboration with other medical doctors and midwife services.

ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Provide health care related to gynaecology and obstetrics to patients, including prevention, diagnosis and treatment.
- Ensure the implementation of **MSF** clinical policies, tools, guidelines and protocols related to gynaecology and obstetrics in order to minimize clinical risk and to extend best reproductive practices.
- In collaboration with other medical colleagues, carry out the collection of quantitative gynaecological data and ensure exhaustive use of management tools in order to improve gynaecological results and to share knowledge among other field specialists.
- Plan and supervise the HR associated processes (recruitment, training, performance evaluation, development and internal/external communication) of the gynaecological staff in order to ensure both an efficient sizing and the amount of knowledge required, to improve people's capabilities and their active participation in influencing the targeted population using preventive practices. This will be done in close coordination with the HR department.
- Supervise the maintenance and running of the gynaecological equipment and drug consumption, preparing new orders when required and ensuring its rational use as well as that pharmacy stock levels are permanently updated and available. This will be done in cooperation with the pharmacist and logistic staff, the management.

MSF SECTION / CONTEXT SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Provide training and supervision on C-sections to the MDs in Maternity Department to ensure their growth and improve their technical skills (provide on the job training and capacity building by assisting C-sections done by the doctors).
- Participate to morning round in Maternity to ensure the provision of quality care according to MSF standard.
- Ensure that MSF guidelines are in use in Maternity in relation to OBGYN activity.
- Collaborate with hospital OT team and MSF IPC Manager to improve IPC in OT.
- Collaborate with hospital OT team and MSF surgical team to improve quality of surgical care in RCH.
- Collaborate with data team and other MDs in Maternity to set up surveillance on surgical infections in Maternity.
- Participate to relevant data collection and data analysis.
- Conduct/participate to M&M meeting related to relevant cases, in line with the specific competence.
- Provide on the job training and capacity building for Maternity team inside and outside the OT.
