Introduction:

Integral mission considers man as the starting point (unit) of development in the effort of developing societies and communities. It considers the development of a whole person's needs i.e. spiritual (proclamation), economic, political and social in totality. The ultimate goal of integral mission is authentic development and transformation through social involvements, which is part of God's plans for humanity as demonstrated by Jesus' life in word and deed described in Colossians 3:17.

Purpose of the role

The Integral Mission Coordinator shall join a Country management team to realize South Sudan Country Strategy that is guided by the forward together directional objectives affirmed on the basis of equipping and empowering World Relief mission in South Sudan to serve the most vulnerable in their communities leading to meaningful physical, economical, spiritual and social transformation.

Key roles and responsibility.

1. Together with CEZ coordinator and promoter provide capacity building for church empowerment, implementation, monitoring and evaluation.
 - Provide support to project staff to develop and follow through local church based holistic approach using the Detailed implementation tool kits (DIG 2.0).
 - Organize and facilitate training programs for South Sudan CEZ and other areas of program reach.
 - Support the Area Coordinators and Program Manager develop and implement Integral Mission plans, interventions and collaboration with partners and stakeholders
 - Facilitate quarterly project technical reviews and planning meetings within World Relief Program areas.



- Ensure integration and mainstreaming of IM in program designs, implementation and monitoring/learning and reporting.
- Conduct field visits in all World Relief areas in South Sudan and more so to World Relief-Community contact places to ensure integral Mission is clearly articulated.

2. Program branding and communication

- Work with Communication, Meal and Business development team to brand and market integral mission concept to World Relief South Sudan, Partners, Church network, donor and beneficiary communities.
- Participate in weekly, monthly and annual reviews of program documents and reports for adherence and compliance with common Humanitarian standard.
- Assist in development and/or contribute towards the development of proposals for funding for CEZ's.

3. Reporting

- Consolidate monthly, quarterly and annual church empowerment matrix and reports from Maridi and Ibba CEZ and timely submit them to the Area Coordinator, M & E and other relevant staff.

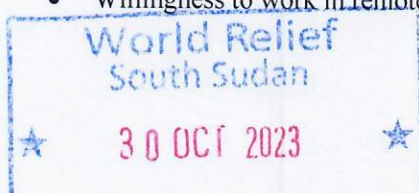
4. Coordination, networking and partnership
