Purpose of the (3) positions:

With technical guidance and mentoring from a Food Assistance Manager, the incumbent will assist in the development, delivery, management, operations and/or maintenance of major/significant FFA infrastructural activities under the FFA projects. The officer will be involved in engineering, architecture and Project management. The infrastructure officer should have experience in Water harvesting, access and feeder roads, water and Flood control dyke construction.

- Candidates should also be willing to live and work in very difficult and security-risk areas
- Must be a **computer literate** in (MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook) with high experience in report writing with a reputable INGO or NNGO.
- Ability to ride a motorbike in harsh terrains during rainy and dry seasons.
- Ability to work under pressure/cope with tight deadlines

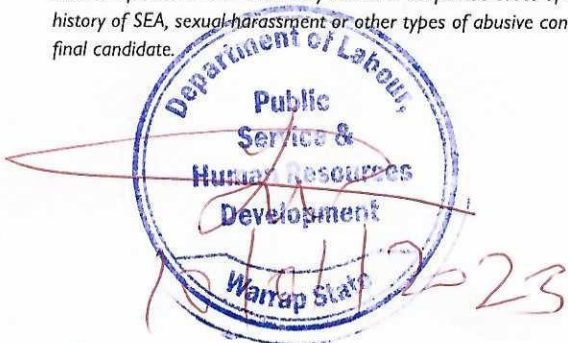
