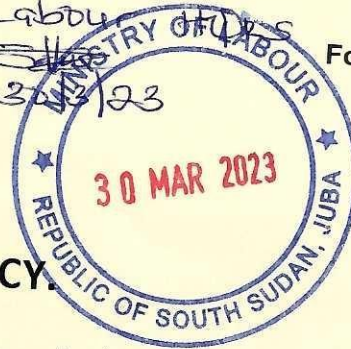

Purpose of the position;

The Reproductive Health Officer implements the reproductive health related activities stipulate in the UNFPA_UNICEF CERHSP-AF program. S/He will conduct evidence-based advocacy for incorporating adolescents and youth SRH needs in Pibor, S/HE will be responsible for coordinating and managing the day-to-day activities of reproductive health and EPI and providing comprehensive technical supervision and support to reproductive health on all activities to ensure that interventions are cost-effective and high impact

Major Roles and Responsibilities;

- Provide overall Reproductive Health technical oversight of all activities to ensure interventions is evidence based culturally appropriate, cost-effective, and high impact.
- Assist and facilitate community participation in Reproductive Health program,
- S/He will give technical support to EPI team and ensure EPI services meet the standard
- Facilitate and train the EPI vaccinators on immunization in practice and COVID19
- Build technical capacity of the service providers, Maternal and Child Health Workers and all the junior staff
- Manage Reproductive Health initiatives both at the community and Health Facilities level,
- Disseminate Reproductive Health guidelines, standards of practice, protocols and other tools to improve quality delivery at Health Facilities.
- Work closely with other counter parts to identify and build cross-sectoral programming.
- Disseminate best practices at community level to community elders, Traditional Birth Attendants and women groups.
- Participate in development, preparation, and dissemination of IEC materials.



- Assist with development of behavior change messages around Reproductive Health
- Ensure continuous provision of SRH supplies required to conduct the SRHR services are available at all times
- Ensure there is good record keeping system and continuous monitoring and regular evaluation of the HR project activities
- Ensure fields report formats are used properly and all reports are submitted on time, followed up on, and finalized in a timely manner and support where issues arise to mentor and improve over time
- Planning and follow up procurement of supplies and prepare a distribution plan for supply to health facilities
- Work closely with the field teams to determine the operational needs of the RH interventions
- Conduct regular and ongoing analysis of reproductive health activities in HFs and prepare monthly progress reports
- Carry out any other responsibilities as requested by the RH coordinator and Lot10 program coordinator
