### PURPOSE OF THE POSITION:

JOB SUMMARY: HFO is looking for one qualified Roving Health Officer with competence and efficient midwifery skills (BMOC& CMOC) to deliver and support Pregnant, Newborns, Lactating mothers and in-patients of all ages in the PHCUs. Such services shall treat all people

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with dignity, respect, care and compassion, recognizing their individual health beliefs, needs and values.

# THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ENROLLED MIDWIFE;

- The Roving Health Coordinator will work in collaboration with the Field Coordinator in and the Consortium lead ACF-USA to coordinate all health activities within the Counties under SSHF.
- Conduct frequent field visits to support to the field coordinator and medical staff including nurses, midwives and other health staff.
- Perform administrative and official duties by meeting other stakeholders coordinate with Juba office or the line Manager in the head office
- Monitor and develop plans of action with the field coordinator and emergency plans for the whole county.
- Give daily update to the Health Manager and Programme Coordinator at Juba Level.
- Maintain an excellence and cooperative relationships with the other partners on ground and the CHD/SMOH.
- Check inventory of medical equipment and other supplies or stock of medicines and place orders in line with the pharmacist/In-charge accordingly.
- Support M&E in making reports and database of the patients, inventory and other necessary documentation on computers including monthly stock reports.
- Attending all necessary NGOs Coordination meetings and give feedback to the health Manager and the Programme Coordinator.
- Work in adherence to the organization's standards, practices and policies
- Work in collaboration with all the staff members and support Surveillance Officers.
- Perform other duties as assigned by his/her Line Manager.
- Supportive monitoring and evaluation to all health facilities.
- Monitor the medical activities, analyze them in the context, with the public health approach and make propositions of possible evolution if necessary.
- Report immediately to the technical referent any problem arising in the service, especially the loss/robbery /damage of medical equipment or medicines.
- Ensure that all enrolled health services of preventive and curative program in primary health care are implemented. Such as Immunization program, Antenatal and postnatal care services, Inpatient services, nutrition and Outpatient services.
- In collaboration with county health Department (CHD) and other staff.
- Proper skills on reporting systems (DHIS 1 & 2, HMIS, EWARS, IDSR 5Ws KOBO tools)
