- Over sees the overall project implementation according to the proposal modalities with compliance and qualities according to donor's requirement.
- Provide technical lead in the development of FSL and environment project indicators, monitoring tools and provide a real time advice to project team through regular field visits
- Establish linkages and strong engagements with all relevant stakeholders such as community sectorial groups, line government departments and project participants.
- The holder will provide technical contribution during proposal developments and budgets
- Identify and build on successful community practices in achieving improved natural resources management at the community level.
- Ensures safeguarding of all project stakeholders including staff, beneficiaries, vendors and children.
- Identify approaches that are climate sensitive and do no harm to mitigate GHGs emissions.
- Coordinate and work with all the program staff and answer technical questions time to time related to natural resource management (NRM), Agriculture and economic empowerment.
