OVERALL DESCRIPTION

About CMD

Christian Mission for Development (**CMD**) is a non-profit, non-governmental, multi-sectoral relief and development organization working to provide holistic services to poor and poverty-stricken communities in South Sudan. Established in 2005, CMD has been in operations alleviating poverty, and helps affected communities rebuild their lives. CMD works with partners to reach hard-to-reach areas with very little or no basic services and significantly in regions affected by wars, poverty, extreme hunger and illiteracy. Our thematic areas includes; Health, Nutrition, Education, WASH, Livelihoods, Shelters and Protection.

Overall purpose of this position

Registered/diploma Midwife will take day-to-day tasks and duties of reproductive health activities at the assigned health facility under the line management of the head of the clinic. The midwife will ensure quality care of reproductive health clients in Health facility to all the clients. This position demands excellent knowledge of reproductive, neonatal health care, strong ability, desire and competence to cooperate with and participate in continued medical education led by Clinical officer to continue the capacity building.

Coordination between the reproductive health and EPI departments within the clinics will need to be strengthened to ensure that all mothers coming for ANC services also receive TT immunisation as per their vaccination status and that all new-borns are vaccinated against Polio and Tuberculosis before leaving the health facilities.

Key roles

- Support the clinic set up.
- Ensure all pregnant mothers receive focused Antenatal care.
- Ensure all pregnant and lactating women receive nutrition education.
- Conduct clinic deliveries and encourage that all the deliveries are done at the facility.
- Provide postnatal care services to the mother and the new-born
- Provide Family Planning (FP)/ child spacing services and ensure the services meet MOH and international guidelines.





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- Ensure infection control in reproductive health units by sweeping, dump dusting, washing, and disinfecting, decontaminating, sterilising and correct use of gloves at all the time before, when and after handling the clients.
- Ensure timely referral of all the cases in the reproductive and neonatal health care.
- Ensure that the daily activities in the reproductive and neonatal health clinics start with health and nutrition education targeting barriers to safe clinic deliveries, exclusive breastfeeding/ good nutrition, hygiene, benefits of postnatal care, Family planning, cord care etc.
- Collect and report Reproductive and neonatal health data to the clinical officer in-charge.
- Ensure that all mothers attending ANC and PNC mothers receive Mosquito nets, soap, IPT for malaria during the visit.
- Ensure that all ANC and PNC mothers receive the right prophylaxis, de-worming and supplementation of various micronutrients as per MOH guidelines to ensure optimal health for both Mother, foetus and new-born.
- Build the capacity of the CHD staffs deployed to the maternity unit by organizing refresher/on-job training
- Identify knowledge gaps within the maternity team and recommend appropriate action to CMD management through the clinical officer and the county health coordinator.

Requirements (qualification/experience/competencies)

- Must be a South Sudanese, residents of the project site will be the priority
- Must have undergone a formal midwifery training for at least 3 years in a recognized learning institution
- Must have been on continuous practice for the past 2 years
- Experience working in insecure area and in an emergency humanitarian response
- Hands on experience in rendering reproductive and neonatal health care services in health facility settings
- Previous experience in Reproductive Health Care programmes with international organisations/ agencies an added advantage
- Good interpersonal skills
- Excellent computer skills and experience in donor reporting and representation
- Fluent in spoken and written English
- Proven organizational skills and time management.
- Very enthusiastic and keen to work extra hours to achieve the objectives of the programme.
