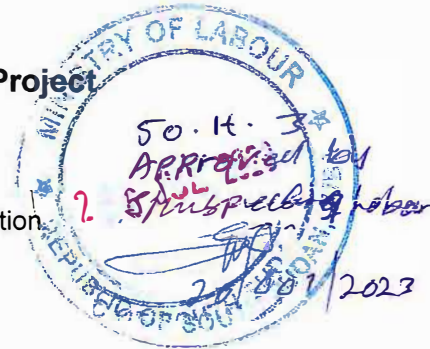

Project Background:

The purpose of the Afia Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (Afia WASH) Project is to expand gender-transformative sustainable access to basic safe drinking water, basic sanitation coverage, and increase uptake of key hygiene behaviors to improve health and household resilience in accordance with USAID/South Sudan's Strategic Framework. The AFIWASH is a USAID funded, 5-year project from October 2021 to September 2026 being implemented in the following 13 counties in South Sudan – Mayendit, Leer, Panyijar, (Unity State), Jur River, Wau (Western Bahr El Ghazal state), Kapoeta North, Budi (Eastern Equatoria state), Baliet, Ulang (Upper Nile State), Akobo, Uror, Duk (Jonglei Stat), and Pibor (Greater Pibor Administrative Area).

Scope of the Assignment:

As part of ensuring sustainable availability and affordability of sanitary pads, Afia WASH Project intends to support the production and marketing of the re-useable menstrual pads and establish material supply chain linkage in the two counties of Kapoeta North, in Eastern Equatoria and Wau County of Western Bahr el ghazal.

The Consultant is therefore, required to:

- i) Develop appropriate training materials and train identified two women groups in Kapoeta North and Wau Counties in production of re-usable sanitary pads.
- ii) Develop market-based approach that will focus on steady production, marketing, and supply chain of the sanitary pads products as well as materials. The developed document will guide both the trained women group and Afia WASH project team in addressing the chronic challenges of unsustainable production and continued availability of produced products in the market.

Level of Effort

It is anticipated that the total duration of the assignment will be 6 weeks (3 weeks for Kapoeta North, and another 3 weeks for Wau County).

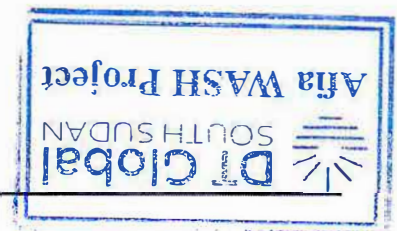
The Performance periods.

Once all other detailed arrangements have been agreed, a final implementation plan will be developed. However, it is envisaged that the performance period will be from August 14th – 30th September 2023.

Educational requirements:

- At least a Diploma from any recognized institution in tailoring or any related field.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in undertaking a similar training of women or youth groups in Menstrual Hygiene Management (re-usable sanitary pad production) in South Sudan.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office programs to develop a program.
- Ability to undertake the assignment with minimal supervision.
