### PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND SUMMARY OF ROLE

The Advancing HIV & AIDS Epidemic Control (AHEC) Activity is a U.S. Department of State-funded initiative implemented in South Sudan by IntraHealth International to strengthen HIV prevention, care, and treatment services. The project approach focusses on Facility and community led responses, strategic case finding, retention in care, and the delivery of high quality, client centered HIV services.

The Community ART Nurse supports community and facility-based HIV service delivery by ensuring adherence to ART, PrEP demand creation for pregnant and breastfeeding mothers, viral load monitoring, and early infant diagnosis (EID). The role is responsible for sample collection, preparation, packaging, transportation, follow-up of laboratory results, and enhanced adherence counseling, while promoting client-centered and safe care practices.

#### Key Functional Focus Areas

- Community-based HIV service delivery and ART support
- Viral load and EID coordination and follow-up
- PrEP demand creation and adherence support
- Sample collection, tracking, and laboratory coordination
- Client-centered care and psychosocial support
- Data collection, reporting, and coordination with Strategic Information teams

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES / ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

#### Clinical and Community HIV Service Delivery

- Provide ART refills, PrEP demand creation, and enhanced adherence counseling for PLHIV.



- Provide basic HIV prevention, treatment, and adherence information to clients in the community.
- Support linkage to care, ART initiation, retention, and re-engagement of clients lost to follow-up.
- Provide psychosocial support and encourage adherence to HIV treatment.

**Viral Load and EID Coordination**

- Coordinate viral load and EID sample collection, preparation, packaging, transportation, and tracking.
- Ensure accuracy of request forms, samples, and dispatch documentation.
- Review sample and results tracking registers weekly and follow up on pending results with facilities and NPHL.

**Community Outreach and Mobilization**

- Support planning and implementation of community outreach HIV interventions.
- Coordinate comprehensive HTS activities with community and facility teams.
- Participate in health education activities using approved IEC materials.

**Data Collection and Reporting**

- Collect, update, and share HIV care and treatment data using approved tools.
- Compile and submit weekly and monthly reports highlighting achievements and challenges.
- Coordinate with Strategic Information teams to ensure accurate data reporting.

**Quality, Safety, and Compliance**

- Ensure adherence to SOPs, infection prevention and control protocols.
- Perform all clinical tasks in line with established policies and guidelines.
- Participate actively in MTD meetings and quality improvement activities.



**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS**

Required Qualifications

- Certificate or diploma in Nursing or Midwifery from a recognized health training institution.
- Training in IMAI or LIVES is preferred.
- At least two (2) years of experience providing HIV/AIDS clinical services.
- Experience implementing community or facility-based HIV programs including HTS, ART, PrEP, and PEP is an advantage.

**SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES**

- Strong communication, negotiation, and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work effectively in a complex and fast-paced environment.



- Good report writing and documentation skills.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
- Strong verbal and written English; Juba Arabic is an asset.
- Commitment to client-centered, ethical, and safe care.
