Position Summary:

MELS seeks to recruit Community Mobilizers who will be the facilitators between the TPM team in Juba, Implementing Partners (IPs) on ground and program participants. The Community Mobilizers will be trained on how to take quality activity photos and mobilize program participants and IPs for interviews with the Juba-based TPM team. The Community Mobilizers report to MELS TPM team based in Juba. This is a short-Term Technical Assistance (STTA) position based in the 14 counties' **Akobo, Ayod, Duk, Fangak, Fashoda, Guit, Koch, Leer, Mayendit, Mayom, Rubkona, Pibor, Ulang and Renk**. currently planned to be monitored by September 2024. Residents and female candidates in these counties are encouraged to apply.



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Responsibilities.

- Assist in organizing telephone interviews between program participants and Juba-based Field Monitors.
- Act as a translator during interviews with program participants.
- Arrange meetings with implementing partners/community partners on the ground.
- Conduct contextual monitoring and on-site observations.
- Follow up with IPs on the implementation of RTPM recommendations.
- Perform any other duties as assigned by the MELS Sector Specialists.

Qualifications:

- Minimum diploma in social science, political science, agriculture, computer science, or related field.
- 3 years of professional experience in a field relevant to the position in a comparable position, preferably with an international NGO or international development organization
- Demonstrated knowledge and skills about raising awareness and facilitating behavioral and social change.
- Familiarity with the local context including with existing community structures and IPs required.
- Recent experience using technological data collection innovations such as tablets, smartphones, Fulcrum, etc.
- Excellent English writing skills and speaking ability.
- Familiarity with the general landscape of South Sudan, including the politics, conflict, culture, language, history, and economy.
