Project background

Welthungerhilfe in South Sudan has been implementing activities in nine locations in the states of Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Greater Equatoria and Unity since 2011, with its programs in humanitarian assistance, rural development, livelihoods, nutrition and food security, and WASH sectors. Currently WHH South Sudan implements projects across the entire South Sudan.

Currently WHH South Sudan implements 2 projects in Rubkona County through the Bentiu Field Office. WHH has secured funding for an Emergency Nutrition Support Project in Rubkona County who's purpose is to enhance access to improved Nutrition services. The project will target at least 30,000 participants including women, children and people living with disabilities.

Job purpose:

The Head of Project provides leadership to the Nutrition Support Project team in Rubkona County. You will be responsible for the overall management of WHHs Nutrition Support Project (NSP) activities You will be expected to coordinate, plan implement and report on the NSP interventions in the assigned area. You will also ensure effective budget and human resource management and work towards sustaining good working relationships with all stakeholders, particularly the UNICEF, Local authorities, other NGOs and community leadership.

Key responsibilities:

- Plan implementation and monitoring of Nutrition Support Project activities to enhance access to functional nutrition services through the provision of emergency nutrition support, WASH, and improved shelter.



- The Head of Project is responsible for managing the team to undertake nutrition treatment centre improvements, support to referral pathways, and promotion of social behaviour change in Rubkona County.
- Establish effective stakeholder networks and also regularly provide relevant feed-back and feed forward to country management and project team.
- Ensure the project has a functional Complaints and Response Mechanism (CRM) as per WHH and WFP guidelines.
- Ensure the project adopts a gender mainstreaming methodology in all its activities.
- Overall project coordination of all aspects of the project including recruitment of staff, development of procurement plans and initiating procurement processes for materials, goods and external services.
- Take responsibility for the timely compilation and submission of quality reports as per donor and WHH requirements and given deadlines.
