- Interns who show genuine desire to serve among the poor in rural and semi urban areas of South Sudan.
- Interns with demonstrated good character, honesty, high competency and generally in good physical and emotional health.
- Interns who are open to declare any potential points for conflict of interest e.g. a family member working for WORLD VISION SOUTH SUDAN & Willingness to commit to the program for a period of one year or at least 9 months.
