Brief organization background

Children Aid South Sudan (CASS) is a National not for profit humantarian organization registered with the Republic of South Sudan relief and rehabilitation commission (RRC) since 2014. CASS has a focus in Health and Nutrition, Education, Protection, Gender Equality, Agriculture and Livelihood with emphasis on Children and Women.

CASS currently operates in 4 of the 10 states of South Sudan with her head office in Juba i.e. Unity State, Upper Nile State, Greater Pibor Administrative Area and Eastern Equatoria State covering 12 Counties. CASS is seeking for qualified south sudanese nationals preferable from the areas for the job location to fill up the advertised positions.

Project backround

After crises erupted in Sudan on 15/04/2023, many livelihoods have been affected resulting to a number of returnees/refugees/assylum seekers crossing into South Sudan through different boarders and settling in different Counties including Rubkona and Guit Counties of Unity States. The increased numbers in the affected Counties resulted to surge in humanitarian needs across sectors including health that existing services in those Counties could no longer hold resulting to the the need for complementary services in order to bridge the gaps. CASS with support from the

health cluster(SSHF reserve allocation 6)/OCHA will be responding to the health needs of these population in Rubkona and Guit Counties of Unity State, Republic of South Sudan.



Position summary

The emergency health project manager will be the project/team lead based at the field level.

Key responsibilities

- Oversee day to day activities of the project and report to the technical advisor
- Ensures timely execution of the project deliverables as per the work plan and budget
- Monitor project progress, identify bottlenecks and institute corrective measures
- Work closely with the health team in Guit and the County health department in both Guit and Rubkona Counties respectively.
- Compile and submit project reports as per donor, MOH and CASS requirements.
- Compile, document success stories and lesson learnt.
- Organize for trainings and mentorship of both project and County health department staff.
- Ensure professional staff contact, good relation with County authorities and beneficiaries of services.
- Ensure all staff understand and have a copy of their job description and staff code of contact.
- Represent organization at coordination meetings at State and County levels.
- Ensure rational use of pharmaceutical supplies and equipments.
- Have up to date record of assets and stock at all times.
- Any other duty as may be assigned by the line manager or person in a similar position.

- Degree in any of the following; medicine, clinical medicine, nursing with experience in both clinical work and project management.
