About us

Christian Aid has a vision of a better world free from poverty. At the heart of this vision is tackling the root causes of poverty, empowering people to have a brighter future, and saving lives during emergencies.

In South Sudan, Christian Aid exists to bring lasting change for all the people of South Sudan, so they live in peaceful coexistence, with dignity and security, taking a full part in the society and the economy; irrespective of their identity.

Christian Aid is responding to the South Sudan humanitarian crisis in a way that will lay the foundations for a broad-based recovery, working with local and national actors to provide emergency and resilient livelihoods support to disaster-affected populations.

We are looking for a dynamic, highly skilled and motivated individual to play a key role in our humanitarian team and supporting our partners in South Sudan.

About the role

As Programme Officer – Humanitarian Response, you will provide accompaniment support to Christian Aid's humanitarian, resilience and disaster risk reduction programme. You will be based in Juba spending considerable time in the field due to the demand of this role. You will play a key role in strengthening CA capacity to prepare for, mitigate against and respond to crises, and in ensuring best practice in our humanitarian response.

You will be responsible for Christian Aid programme-wide humanitarian projects being implemented by partners and will actively support humanitarian programme development, fundraising, implementation, representation in coordination meetings and monitoring. You will provide effective and timely support to partner organizations, enabling them to respond to emergencies, and ensuring that this is in line with Christian Aid's country programme strategy.

You will have an external facing role, helping Christian Aid to engage with donors, representing the organization at coordination / cluster meetings, ensuring CA humanitarian projects are included in HRP and working collaboratively with Christian Aid humanitarian, fundraising, and communications and media colleagues in the South Sudan office and the region.

About you

To make this happen, you will have considerable experience of implementing and managing Cash Based programming, Shelter, WASH, protection, Food Security and livelihoods interventions, safeguarding and accountability and use of digital platforms for M&E. You will have a passion about working with local and national actors and putting affected populations at the center of our work. You recognize, and the nature of the work requires field monitoring and accompaniment in difficult and hard to reach locations and in some situation being temporarily relocated in the field when deemed appropriate by the management for the purpose of accompanying partner led response.

You will have a good knowledge of emergency coordination and linking relief to rehabilitation and development, including organizational development and capacity building techniques. You will have considerable experience of hands on grants management, working with local partners, and proactively dealing with challenges as they arise.

You will support fundraising and leveraging resources, writing well and being systematic in your approach to system and processes. You will be an excellent communicator with the ability to develop cross-organisational relationships and be confident in engaging with external networks and donors.

You will have a broad range of technical and professional skills around programme cycle management, including proposal development, grant management, leading need assessments, Post Distribution Monitoring (PDMs), and donor reporting. Above all you will be proactive in supporting partners to develop and implement humanitarian programmes.
