Job title: Freelance/Casual Actors in Toposa and Didinga. <u>Start date, July 2022 but pending Donor's approval.</u>

BBC Media Action uses media and communications to reduce poverty and promote human rights in developing countries. To achieve this, it partners with civil society organisations, local media and governments to:

- Produce creative programmes based on robust research in multi-media formats which inform and engage audiences around key development issues.
- Strengthen the media sector through building professional capacity and infrastructure.

BBC MA in South Sudan is looking for freelance actors – men and women – to take part in an episodic radio drama programme (Life in Lulu series 7 and 8). The theme of the story is peaceful co-existence, tolerance and stability.

The casual actors will work full days or half days as and when required by the organisation's Senior Producer drama Director or Production Manager.

This is occasional work only, with a maximum requirement of one or two day (s) per week as needed.

Actors would need to be available in Juba at least for a minimum of 4 months and ready to work during workdays (no weekend recordings) to be considered for the roles.

The role requires excellent acting skills, spoken, reading and writing ability in Didinga and Toposa languages.

They are also required to have strong spoken English skills, and a flair for making their audiences believe in their characters.

The successful Actors will be required to adhere to the BBC Media Action code of conduct and safeguarding policy – including undertaking a mandatory briefing. BBC Media Action operates a zero-tolerance policy concerning all forms of abuse and exploitation of vulnerable people.

You do not need to submit a CV or written application, but you MUST register Express your interest via email and indicate the language of your interest. E.g Toposa or Didinga, please also include your phone numbers. The audition will last up to 15 minutes, and you will be required to perform an act in front of a panel along with other candidates.
