## Storytelling videographers and photographers in South Sudan Call for expression of interest

May 2026

Tearfund is a Christian International Organisation. Our vision is to see people freed from poverty, living transformed lives, and reaching their God-given potential. In South Sudan, Tearfund seeks to enable people and communities in vulnerable situations to recover from crises, seek durable solutions to displacement and build resilience to acute shocks and chronic stresses through targeted programming in specific geographic areas.

We are seeking a professional videographer and photographer to capture compelling film footage and photos that showcase different aspects of Tearfund work in Aweil, South Sudan.

The work will take place from the 22nd to 28th June, 2026.

Specifically, we are looking for a freelancer to provide the following:

### Video requirements

- Capture raw footage in 4k filmed in LOG format (B-roll, interview footage, etc) that can be used to develop a range of digital assets and videos.
- Microphone requirements: shotgun mics for gathering general sound, and lav (lapel/clip-on) mics for gathering interviews to ensure the quality of sound.
- Upload or share video content with appropriate labelling and descriptions in organised folders within 2 weeks of returning from the trip.
- Supply all as raw rushes.
- Assist with collecting User-generated content – help project participants capture footage using phones or a camera.

### Photography requirements

- Capture high-quality, strong and varied images of the everyday lives of those who participate in Tearfund's projects.
- Sort and add captions (in English) to selected 800 - 1000 images and share through WeTransfer. The standard we request for images is hi-res JPEG files with a maximum file size of 25MB per image (minimum 2MB) - 36x24cm (or thereabouts) @ 300dpi.
- Deliver the photography selection within 2 weeks after the end of the trip.

### Transcription requirements

- Provide transcriptions of all video interviews with their translation (from Dinka Aweil to English) with relevant timecode - A guide will be provided.



**A full creative brief will be provided to the successful candidate.**

**Requirements:**

- At least 3-5 years of progressive experience in videography
- Ability to travel to project locations outside of the city
- Proven ability to collect high-quality photos and videos including audios in a variety of environments
- Have the required permits/accreditation to take photos and to film in South Sudan
- Must have his/her photo, video and audio equipment. Make sure you have protective measures to prevent equipment failure in case of intense sun or heavy rains, and ensure high-quality production.
- Strong storytelling skills
- Experience working with Humanitarian and Development organisations.
- Creativity, flexibility, and being able to work unsupervised.
- Fluent in English
- Must agree to a GDPR compliant contract (inc. safeguarding and data storage policies etc.

Interested candidates may send the following:

- Updated CVs with relevant experiences, education, and references
- Updated portfolio with Work samples
- Cover Letter expressing interest and suitability for the assignment
- Company Licenses: Copies of your current Registration Certificate, Business License, VAT registration, and TIN.
- Financial proposal outlining the proposed rate per day for photography, videography and post- production (Organise and export Raw video content into appropriate folders, transcription)
- Please note that all the other costs regarding accommodation, meals, and transport will be at the charge of the selected candidate
- Equipment details
- Accreditation or proven permission to photograph and Film in the country.
