Job Purpose

The anesthetist will be a key Staff in the team providing Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and Neonatal Care. (CEMoNC) and Surgical Services in hospital.

As an anesthetist, you will assess Patient's health and discuss types of anesthetic suitable for them (general, local or regional) administer appropriate anesthetic before Surgery, Minor. Their well being during Surgery and provide care after medical procedures. You will also deal with emergencies in Theatre and in Wards. Patient can range from babies to elderly and include Pregnant Woman (during Child birth), those undergoing Operation and those with chronic pain.

You will spend the majority of your time working in a hospital Operating theatre, but will work in other department, such as a resuscitations services, obstetrics unit, Critical Care Services and emergency department. The job can be emotionally and Physically demanding as you will be providing anesthetic and pain relief to patient of all age, from babies and Pregnant woman through to the elderly, Sometimes in emergencies.

Major Responsibilities.

As an anesthetist, you will need to:

- Asses weather a patient is fit enough to undertake an Operation before Surgery take place.
- Agree on anesthetic Plan.
- Reassure Patient about what happen during and after the operation.
- Get patient ready for surgery.
- Initiate anesthesia, providing safe Pre- operative care and pain relief to patient using anesthetic and Analgesics
- Continuous anesthesia in the operating Theatre.
- Monitor patient's, while they are under anesthesia to make sure they remain in a stable condition checking Vital sign, Pulse and Respiration.
- Resuscitation and stabilize patient during emergency.
- Reverse anesthesia and relieve and manage Post- Operative pain to Support patient's recovery.
- Provide Care for patient in chronic pain.
- Work with a range of other health Professional, such as Surgeon, Operating department practitioners, Theatre nurse, radiologists, to ensure patients wellbeing.

- Perform administrative task in area which related to the care of patient, including summaries of patient's treatment and writing of discharge letter.
- Attend multidisciplinary team meetings.
- Participate in an agreed-on call note and take on an equal share in providing emergency cover.
- Train, teach and supervise more junior staffs in both critical care and anesthesia.
- Maintain an IPC in the Theatre and ensure the environment is clean and sterile for procedure and collaborate with other staffs working in the theatre.
- Ensure appropriate usage of medicine and medical supplies, consumable in theatre and make requisitions promptly.
- Ensure all anesthesia equipment are in proper working condition and report any malfunction timely.
- Submit weekly / monthly reports are required.
- Perform another relevant task as necessary in ensuring quality Services delivery through team work.

Required Qualification

- You should have worked as an anesthetist for at least 3 years, Preferably in a well- equipped in operation Theatre.
- You will need to be professional, flexible and work ethically to a code of conducts
- You will need to have a comprehensive knowledge of anesthetic and procedure, ability to organize and prioritize your work load.
- Strong Communication skills, both written and spoken **English** and Knowledge of basic **Arabic** in **South Sudan**
- Steady hand – eye coordination
- A knowledge of your clinical and professional strength and limitation.
- Team work skill and ability to work well under pressure and conformable in a multi- cultural environment
- A Compassionate attitude towards patients and good leadership, qualities.
- The ability to manage personal stress and fatigue.
- Decision – making and problem-solving skills and situational awareness.
- At least a **Diploma in Anesthesia** from a verifiable, recognized training Institution.
- A **Degree in Anesthesia** (Will be much preferred).
