Terms of reference for documenting the impact of the grant.

Brief introduction

Norwegian Church Aid (NCA), Finn Church Aid (FCA) together with two third- party entities, are implementing a grassroot level peacebuilding and reconciliation activities support project in Greater Upper Nile, Greater Pibor Administrative Area, and Kapoeta East County. The project aims to contribute to building sustainable peace and reconciliation in South Sudan, by increasing intra/inter community groups interactions/healing by ensuring that the communities co-exist peacefully and interact freely within and across communal boundaries. - 3. Produce a short video clip and share it with NCA.
- 4. Translate/voice over where necessary.

- 2. 3-year work experience with local and International non- governmental organizations.
- 3. Registered journalist with Media Association of South Sudan is preferred.
- 4. Strong communication and analytical skills.
