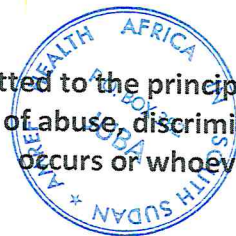

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Purpose of the Job:

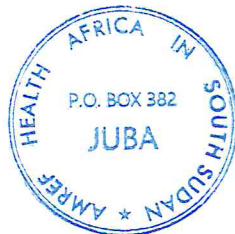

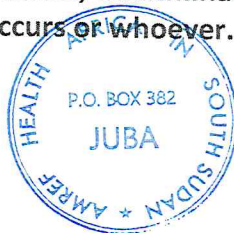

Job Opportunity (Maternal Neonatal Health Project Officer) 2020

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Purpose of the Job:

The MNCH Officer will provide technical oversight for the design and implementation of an integrated and context-appropriate MNCH package at community, primary health facility, and referral levels. S/He will work in liaison with the Lot Coordinator to ensure the effective implementation of quality maternal new-born and child health services in compliance with donor requirements and evidence-based practices, timely reporting on project indicators with a bias to Maternal, New Borne and Child Health. S/He is collocated at CHD for technical support.
