## Purpose of the position:

As part of its protection in emergencies, programming World Vision provides protection prevention and responds services through Refugee and IDP in the community. Provide mobilization /sensitization for community to help in peaceful of co-existence and creation of awareness of reaction on human right and Child right.

- Organize and plan for implementation of project activities weekly and monthly meeting.
- To coordinated with project coordinators on how to distributed core relief items at site.
- Provided plans for capacity building and training of community on protection concerns.
- To provide daily monitoring plan to monitors on movement of Refugee at the boarders' site.

- Ensure timely submission of periodic reports weekly and monthly and over all supervisor for staffs, protect ion staffs project are train to report good quality weekly report to made interested of organization.
- Ensure that good care for project materials are properly care and distributed to Child friendly space community as need by partners and world vision.
