Position: Inclusive Education Worker

Duty Station: Juba City

INGO Overview:

OVCI la Nostra Famiglia is an Italian International Organization focused on enhancement of health, living condition and rights of children and adults with disability.

OVCI has been present in Juba, South Sudan since 1983 to carry out basic health, education and rehabilitation activities for people with disabilities, with a special focus on the age of development.

OVCI in Juba is committed in:

1. Rehabilitation services through the management of a Rehabilitation Centre, an Orthopaedic Workshop and the promotion of surgical interventions in Uganda for children with disabilities.
2. Primary Care Health services, through the management of a PHCC, excellence in the treatment of epilepsy, and a nutritional programme for ante-natal and post-natal care.

3. Community-based Inclusive Development (CBID) program aimed at enhancing inclusivity of children and adults with disabilities in the South Sudanese society.
4. Inclusive Education program, through a pre-school for children with impairments and activities targeting public schools.
5. University services development, by collaborating in the management of the degree course in Rehabilitation Sciences at St. Mary's College

Project description:

OVCI - la Nostra Famiglia has been granted by Christian Blind Mission (CBM) Germany to implement a 48 months development project with the overall goal of contributing to strengthening the access to quality inclusive education and to rehabilitation services for people with disabilities in Juba City Council. The project includes many activities embracing every aspect of people with disability's lives. In fact, this project is designed on a Community Based Inclusive (CBID) approach, which is a strategy to improve the quality of life of Persons with Disability. The CBID is designed on the Human Rights model of disability which, according to UN Convention for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD), has to promote a life as equal citizens in the community, to have access to health services, participate in educational programs, and enjoy social, cultural, religious, economic and political activities to every person or child with disability.

Description of tasks and duties:

Inclusive Education work is a practice-based profession and an academic discipline that promotes inclusive education for primary and secondary schools, social change and development, empowerment and dignity for students with disabilities. Principles of social justice, human rights, collective responsibility and respect for diversities are central to social work. Underpinned by academic background in teaching and education for students and knowledge on pupils with disabilities needs, Inclusive Education work engages people and structures to address education needs and challenges of children and teenager with disabilities.

The main task of the Inclusive Education Worker will be:

1. Support the project coordinator and the team in assessing the students, in order to identify education, social and health needs and develop an action plan for each student.
2. Weekly follow-up on the students assigned and coordinate with the team for referring the children to the adequate health, rehabilitation and social service provided by OVCI; conduct home-visits for the students, with autonomy and in team;
3. Train the caregivers and the pupils with disabilities in home-based academic approach, home education support for the children.
4. Under the supervision of the Project Coordinator, visit and build a reliable relationship with the schools assigned by the management, coordinate with the teachers, the PTA and the parents of the pupils with disabilities. Support the implementation of the project activities in the schools, as teachers training, awareness, education support and inclusive tools application, etc.;

5. Participate in staff trainings and learn the principles and application of Community- based Inclusive Development Approach and its application. Learn and apply the referral system internal to Usratuna OVCI services (Health, Rehabilitation, Nutrition, etc.)
6. Fulfil in a timely and qualitative manner all the data collection form and participate in coordination meeting. Track and report the progress of the beneficiaries target and the activities implemented.
7. Work in respect of the UN Convention for Rights of People with Disability, ensuring equity and non-discrimination and properly representing OVCI in the schools and area target.
8. Any other duty assigned by the management.

Candidate profile:

- Certificated qualifications in education and/or teaching for primary and secondary schools (copy of original qualification) or equivalent professional experience;
- At least 1 years of previous demonstrated experience in the role;
- South Sudanese nationality
- Birth certificate copy
- Recommendation letter from previous employer
- Precise and active worker, able to follow given disposition;
- Timely and motivated worker;
- Skills in using Microsoft Office tools preferred but not mandatory;
- Demonstrated capacity to successfully work in team;
