Location: Pibor and Jebel Boma.

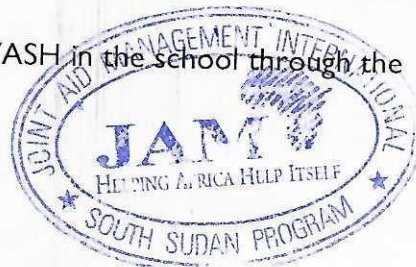
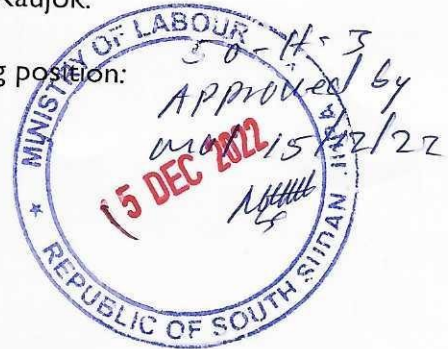

Purpose of the position;

The Boma health initiative officer will be responsible for implementation of Boma health initiative project and all community related health activities in Greater Pibor administrative Area (GPAA) county, he/she will be working close with CHD to provide support to the community of Pibor county in addressing specific health activities meant to enhance improve access to quality and equitable health services to the most vulnerable group, also to support training/capacity building of Boma health workers and their supervisors, support supervision, provide ongoing mentorship and support preventive services

Major Roles and Responsibilities;

- Schedule and facilitate training of BHWs and BHWs supervisors on child health condition.
- Establish Boma Village Health Committee BVHC and ensure the committee take charge of their facilities and participate in activities such as cleaning and community engagement.
- Facilitate regular BVHC meetings with representation from CHD and community leaders and establish community feedback system regarding health service delivery
- In liaison with County health director, RRC and other county authorities, organizing community meetings and campaign forum that promote participation of communities and involvement in effort to improve maternal and child health
- Compile and submit in a timely manner and accurate monthly BHI report to M&E and health coordinator
- Strengthen the appropriate use of HMIS data within the communities in correct interpretation, ensure the availability of the HMIS in the health facilities with basic health package of South Sudan
- Improve the good health practice including the WASH in the school through the continuous health education by school health club



- Ensure there is continuous awareness raise on health related issues in the community.
- Coordinate with Facility staff & CHD to ensure good management of health facilities, drugs, and assets at all levels of the facilities (phcu & phcc).
- Reporting,
 - Write weekly reports every Friday by 4PM
 - Report all incidences affecting UNICEF, World Bank project service delivery within 24hrs
 - Provide monthly Boma health initiative report by 8th of every month
 - Provide quarterly report within the first week of the next quarter
- Execute any other tasks as and when assigned by the supervisor
