- In collaboration with Colleagues and Departments, design the Market Based Sanitation Process Map for the pilot project
- Ensure market research is undertaken and analysed on the different sanitation market actors
- Ensures delivery of project's deliverables and achievement of project objectives
- Lead in setting up sato pan installed into various slabs.
- Be able to technically explain the retrofitting of the sato process, cost and requirement to the beneficiaries.
- Develop results matrices, targets, indicators and Weekly/Monthly tracking of results for each component of the MBS project.
- Support in data collection both Qualitative & Quantitative data, and analysis, reporting that align with the project portfolio.
- In collaboration with colleagues, develop and oversee delivery of marketing and sales strategy, ensuring engagement of all four segments of the sanitation market (buyers, suppliers, fitters, financers).
- Monitor all aspects of the project implementation including both project delivery aspects (e.g. budget, activities) and sanitation market aspects (e.g. sales, finances, profitability)
- Participate and share learning in regular cross-region workshops (pilot projects also being undertaken in DRC and Rwanda)
- Conduct regular visits to project implementation sites, advice and support project participants with the identification and resolution of technical issues.



- Using market research and intelligence, support the MBS team in developing and promoting Sanitation Products.
- Undertake regular field visits in liaison with the sales team to ensure the right mix of buyers and Sanitation products.
- Create and manage relationships with stakeholders and networks with the existing distributors of Sanitation products, their buyers/clients, and potential beneficiaries to ensure community promotions, penetration, and last-mile delivery of products.
- Ensure Mansions are trained with retrofitting SaTo Pans and Capacity building provided on networking of promotion of Sanitation Products.
- Works closely with Microfinance institutions or Cooperatives or Savings groups to ensure acquisition of Sanitation products is financed with ease using the available sources of lending
- Set up and maintain a documentation system in accordance with Tearfund standards and procedures to
 ensure that all information is accurately recorded, effective and easily accessible, in consultation with the
 AC.
- Perform any other task that falls within the main obligation according to the need for the program.
