SCOPE AND AUTHORITY

Scope of the Role:

The job holder is accountable for fulfilling his or her roles and responsibilities in line with Islamic Relief values and principles of fairness, humanity, honesty, respect and fair treatment of his/her colleagues and staff.

Responsibility for Resources: None.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Ensure the implementation and continuity of antenatal and postnatal care, family planning, emergency obstetrical and neonatal care in accordance with MoH and reinforce the implementation of standardized protocols.
- Properly follow up of all newborn babies from delivery until discharge, informing mothers and relatives about importance of breast feeding, vaccination and possible complications resulting from harmful traditional practices
- Ensure patients' right to privacy and confidentiality is respected
- Assess the feasibility for referral of pregnant women for medical evacuation and/or complicated delivery
- Ensure hygiene and sterilization criteria are met according to standard specifications

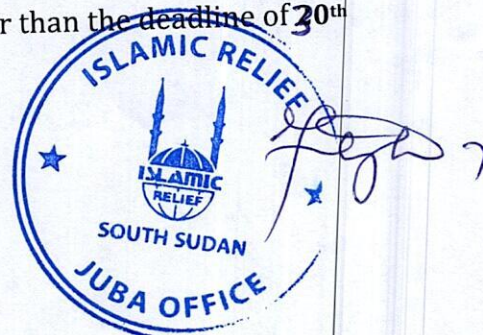
