Clinical Officer-SC Pibor, South Sudan

Job Purpose: To contribute to the achievement of the project goal of reducing morbidity and mortality through supporting diagnosis and management of SAM patients with complications at the Stabilisation Centre (SC) in Pibor County.

Key Responsibilities

Technical

- Provide quality inpatient care to children with Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM) and complications in the SC with strict adherence to protocols established in the South Sudan Inpatient Management of Severe Acute Malnutrition and international guidelines (WHO) as well as implementation of correct feeding practices.
- Ensure appropriate triage is taking place at the clinic's screening point.
- Ensure appropriate Mother, Infant and Young Child Nutrition (MIYCN) messaging is taking place in the SC, along with BF assessments and support to early childhood development (ECD) with nursing staff.
- Ensure that referrals are made to the relevant OTP sites with regular follow ups of patient with the partners including home visits.
- Support the health team by consulting patients and/or supporting where needed if requested.

Management

- Line manages the SC staff; nurses, casuals, cooks, cleaners his includes: conducting regular appraisals, providing daily supervision, and capacity building of staff under the overall supervision and leadership of the SC supervisor/medical manager.
- In charge of managing all aspects of the SC under the overall supervision and leadership of the SC supervisor/medical manager.

Monitoring & Evaluation

- Responsible to collect and report accurate, relevant and timely SC data on monthly basis.
- Responsible to write/communicate to Medical Manager, monthly achievements/challenges of the SC
- Responsible to maintain drug supply in the SC, ensure weekly stock inventories and requests.
- Supervise nutrition nurses and ensure admission cards are completed correctly.
- Feedback/suggest to line manager ways to improve quality of care and monitoring.

Information/Communication

- Develop and maintain a transparent, honest and supportive communication structure with team members and other Medair staff to uphold a spirit of unity and mutual respect.

Logistics and finance

- Follow Medair procedures regarding purchases and expenses.
- In collaboration with MM, timely order drugs and other supplies as well as teaching/promotion material.
