SCOPE OF WORK

LiveWell is a healthcare non-profit organization working in South Sudan to help people affected by conflict or in needs of essential healthcare, WASH, Nutrition, FSL and GBV services.

UNCERF & UN OCHA supported the response scale-up of health services in foods insecure county of Pibor to urgently set-up an operational theater to manage emergency surgical/obstetrics cases in Pibor Town and its surrounding payams. LiveWell in partnership with WHO will support the upgrading of Pibor PHCC to CEMONC center.

Anaesthetistis urgently required to support the running of CEMONC activities in the theater and his/her main role will be to provide evidence-based, safe, high quality pre& post-operative care and anesthetics drugs to all patients requiring surgeries at Pibor PHCC.

KEY ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIE

- Assess all patients preoperatively either in OPD or on the ward and document accurately on the anaesthetic chart and explain all anaesthetic procedures precisely.
- Organize preoperative investigations ii required and check results prior to surgery.
- Discuss all problem patients with the Medical doctor in charge and communicate effectively with the surgeon.
- Check that all equipment in theatre is functional before starting the list and ensure adequate emergency oxygen supply is available.
- Administer a safe and ensure fully documentation of all procedures and drugs on the anesthetic chart.
- Monitor closely patient reaction to anesthesia and surgery.
- Prescribe intravenous fluids for the immediate postoperative period if required.
- Advise the Medical officer on appropriate postoperative analgesia and doses.
- Actively participate in the postoperative recovery care in Pibor PHCC.
- Review all patients postoperatively.
- Attend the hospital CME meetings and morbidity and mortality meetings.
