Background	War Child Canada is a registered Canadian charity-based in Toronto that works with war-affected communities to help children reclaim their childhood through access to education, opportunity and justice. War Child Canada has over 15 years of experience working in communities in conflict and post-conflict zones. All work is implemented in direct partnership with local communities, local NGOs and other stakeholders using a child-centered approach. War Child Canada works in Afghanistan, Iraq, Uganda, Sudan, South Sudan, and Democratic Republic of the Congo.
Context	War Child Canada's holistic approach in South Sudan works to eliminate the cycle of violence and poverty through increasing economic opportunity, community-based protection and conflict mitigation, and education. This work is currently taking place in Upper Nile and Western Bahr el Ghazal states, with a country office in Juba. War Child Canada works to increase the participation of youth in education improving overall quality of education and learning outcomes. War Child Canada's livelihoods and food security work in South Sudan increases food production through work with both farmers and pastoralists. War Child Canada's protection work in South Sudan strengthens the capacity of key community institutions and structures to detect, prevent and respond to all forms of violence and abuse against children and women in their communities.
Position Purpose	The M&E Officer position is a full-time position that will requires travels to the field locations (Wau, Malakal and Awerial). The M&E Officer will provide donor(s) with high-quality technical leadership assistance, M&E services and training, and other related support services. The M&E Officer will be responsible for collecting Information as per the agreed Monitoring and Evaluation Plan, collating and inputting all the information gathered according to the agreed mandatory fields for completion in the database. Data must be managed efficiently, with accuracy and in relation to the timing requirements in support of field team requirements for reporting. The M&E Officer should ensure that all data collected and entered is accurate and must ensure effective coordination and planning with field staff central to all resulting information flow, the post holder should understand their position in having access to and managing a large volume of confidential information. The integrity and professionalism of the post holder is therefore an essential and non-negotiable attribute required of this post.
Tasks & Responsibilities	The main duties include, but are not limited to: 1. Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E): • Support the development and implementation an M&E strategy (per the approved M&E Plan) outlining M&E systems for data collection, targeting and tracking custom and

regulations.

- Support the M&E Manager in working closely with other technical units in establishing and managing cloud-based MEL system and ensure data requirements are integrated into project management processes.
- Develop and implement a results-based M&E Plan and methodology for specific program.
- Collect and analyze qualitative and quantitative data to measure the performance, impact, and sustainability of existing projects as per the agreed M&E Plan.
- Create and standardize quantitative and qualitative monitoring tools to monitor key processes, outputs, and outcome indicators relate to each sector of intervention.
- Ensure quality of data collected by carrying our routine data quality assurance measures; training and supervising data collectors; and ensuing proper data cleaning and data management.
- Create effective M&E systems to support monitoring activities.
- Facilitate Collaborating, Learning and Adapting (CLA) strategies to support the use of data and information from the M&E system for real-time decision-making to improve project implementation.
- Provide oversight to field team on project activities, data collection and analysis, and to ensure the timely completion of M&E activities.
- Provide guidance and oversight to team leaders, evaluation teams, and other staff members on the following: budgeting and expenses, evaluation activities, and on-the-ground logistics.
- Producing clear and quality reports that demonstrate accountability and learning.
- Collecting best practices, case studies which demonstrate qualitative and quantitative changes over the period.
- Complete other duties as necessary and assigned by the M&E Manager.

2. Technical Leadership/Assistance:

- Provide "technical leadership"-including technical assistance, guidance, and directionrelated to M&E plans and systems, performance management, etc.
- Support the technical development of a web-enabled database for data collection, reporting, and integration.
- Supervise and provide support to program evaluations and assessments throughout the life of the program.
