Background:

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) in South Sudan has been implementing activities in nine locations in the states of Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Greater Equatoria and Unity since 2011, with its programs in humanitarian assistance, rural development, livelihoods, nutrition and food security, and WASH sectors. Currently WHH South Sudan implements 19 projects across South Sudan.

Welthungerhilfe received the funding from the South Sudan Humanitarian Fund (SSHF) to implement a Water, Sanitation and Hygiene project in Panyijar county in Unity State. The project is a 12-month intervention which objective is to enhance access to WASH facilities for over 25,000 people in Ganyliel and Nyal. The Head of Project will be based in Nyal. The project objectives will be met through a package of activities that include rehabilitation of water points, rehabilitation of latrines, installation of SWAT systems and provision of sanitation kits to identified beneficiaries in Panyijar.

Job purpose:

The Head of Project takes lead in planning and implementation of project activities in the county. He/She will be expected to manage the project team to achieve the project goals as well as coordinate with other WHH projects in realising complementarity of support provided to the population of the county.

Key responsibilities:

- Prepare monthly work plans and reports and ensure there are submitted timely.
- Ensure quality implementation of all WASH activities in the project area.
- Prepare accurate and timely procurement and financial requests based on the approved workplans

- Provide technical support to the field officers and Community hygiene promoters
- Oversee technical implementation of rehabilitation and construction of WASH facilities.
- Prepare timely technical and progress reports and inform the Emergency Program Coordinator any challenges that influence the quality and timely implementation of the project.
- Manage staff according to WHH leadership principles, staff policies and WHH strategy.
- Work in close coordination with the FSL team of the project, logistics and financial departments
- Ensure the project attains integration, complementarity and partnerships with other humanitarian projects implemented by other actors in Nutrition, Education, Health and FSL.
- Build and sustain cordial relationships with local authorities and community leaders.
- Represent WHH in WASH networks in the project area

Your profile:

- A higher or polytechnic degree in Public Health, Water and sanitation engineering, WASH management or equivalent qualifications that are commensurate with this position.
- 3-5 years of works experience in the WASH sector, implementing hygiene promotion and WASH programs in rural communities. Experience with behaviour change activities in sanitation and hygiene and at least 1 year experience in managing WASH projects.
- Experience in menstrual hygiene management is an added advantage
- At least 3 years' experience coordinating WASH field teams and activities
- Experience in planning and overseeing rehabilitation and construction of WASH facilities
- Team player and strong coordination/ planning skills
- Ability to create positive relationships with colleagues, local authorities, and communities
- Excellent spoken and written English and Arabic. Knowledge of local language is an asset
