Purpose of the position:

To implement the Community based Management of Acute Malnutrition Programme – CMAM through identification and treatment of malnourished cases, monitor progress of the cases to discharge

Key Responsibilities

- Take active roles in identification of malnourished cases through anthropometric measurements
- Work closely and support with Nutrition Nurses at the Nutrition centers to treat and follow up cases of acute malnutrition
- Ensure that the Criteria for admission and discharge are followed and maintained as per national guidelines/WHO and Sphere standards
- Periodic monitoring of the OTP activities in the center
- Participate actively during the Nutrition Assessments i.e. nutrition survey and rapid assessments whenever required

- Work closely with food aid team in monitoring the trend of acute malnutrition for the vulnerable groups i.e. under five children, pregnant and lactating mothers using the required standard protocols and tools.
- Prepare a weekly and Bi weekly reports of children, pregnant and lactating mothers who are enrolled in the program (Admitted, cured, defaulter, absentee etc.)
- Keep and maintain use of the register books, individual cards, take home cards and other relevant report forms to fill all the beneficiary information and all data required as per protocol and ensure these records are updated regularly and well-kept in the proper filing system as required

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

- This position requires a mature candidate, a self-starter, with dedication and ability to work with less or no supervision. Must demonstrate willingness to learn and work with others as a team.
- Holder of Diploma or certificate in Nutrition studies
- Must have 3 years' experience in relief commodity management, Nutrition programming & Management, and Nutrition survey and assessments.
- Willing to work under extreme hardship with limited resources.
- Must possess excellent oral and written communication skills in the English language and knowledge of the local Arabic language

This position requires a person who is self-starter, who can accomplish the tasks with little or no supervision. He/she must be diligent in paperwork, have integrity and be able to cooperate with concerned business clients

Candidates should also be willing to live and work in very difficult and security-risk areas.

Candidate must be culturally sensitive and able to cope with tension, and take impartial neutral decisions as necessary.

Good command of oral and written English is a must. Candidate must also be computer literate with proven skills in Spreadsheets and Word-processing. Should possess a clean driving license.
